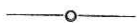

HISTORIQUE DE LA CONFRERIE

The Brotherhoods (Confreries) date back to the Middle-Ages when they were instituted along with Corporations. The latter aimed at the protection, welfare and interest of the people connected with the wine business, whereas the Confreries looked after the spiritual aspect. The patronage of St. Vincent, Christian martyr of the Diocletian persecution who died in Valencia, Spain in 304 A.D., resulted from the fact that King Childebert desposited relics of the saint in the cathedral at Macon, France. Various inquiries within old mutual aid societies in Macon made it possible to organize Confreries who in turn had Chapters for friends and guests of the City of Macon, known for the prestige of its good wines.
