We are thrilled to see what your career as an educator brings, and we believe you will help to continually educate future general dentists on how to navigate endodontics.

I am also happy to report our growth in providing access to endodontic care! Since the launch of our domestic access to care support program two years ago! AAE members have had the opportunity to seek funding to positively impact their community with free access to the highest level of specialty care to underserved patients.
