Executive Summary

PART 1 OF 5

National endodontic treatment volume declined two consecutive years — and the pace is accelerating.

01

Methodology refresh applied uniformly across all years.

Per the November 2025 NADP membership projection update, U.S. treatment, patient, and state-level projections have been refreshed. Values from the prior deliverable have been impacted; YoY comparisons in this report use the current methodology consistently across 2023, 2024, and 2025.

02

Treatment volume: –2.3% in 2024, then –5.7% in 2025.

Commercially-insured endodontic treatment volume declined in both years, with the pace of decline more than doubling year-over-year; Note: Overall treatment volume is affected by the projected decrease in commercial dental insurance membership.

03

Patient volume held up better than treatment volume.

Patient counts increased modestly in 2024 (+1.1%) before declining in 2025 (–2.1%) — a milder pattern than treatment-volume losses.

04

Quarter-over-quarter seasonality remains intact.

Endodontic volume continues to peak in Q1 (when annual benefits renew) and decline gradually through the year.

05

Subcategory mix is shifting toward 'other' procedures.

Endodontic therapy and pulpotomy lost market share YoY; pulp capping and 'other' (notably intraorifice barriers) gained share.

Geography and demographics: every major state declined in 2025; only patients age 65+ grew in 2024.

01

All eight largest states declined in 2025.

Top states by 2025 volume — CA, FL, IL, NY, PA, TX, VA, WA — saw declines from -4.2% (Florida) to -15.2% (New York). The state mix vs. last year reflects updated NADP state-level projections.

02

Patients age 65+ were the only growing cohort in 2024.

65+ treatment grew +4.1% in 2024 before declining a modest -2.4% in 2025; all younger groups declined in both years, with the steepest declines in the 0-19 segment (-4.0%, -8.9%).

03

65+ continues to gain treatment-volume share.

Year-over-year, the 65+ cohort accounts for a larger share of treatments while every younger cohort loses share.

04

Endodontists are the most resilient provider type.

Endodontist-performed treatment volume declined only -0.7% in 2024 and -2.0% in 2025 — materially smaller than declines for GPs (-2.5%, -7.0%) and other specialists (-6.5%, -13.7%).

Endodontists continue to gain provider-share — across subcategories and across tooth types.

01

Endodontist treatment share is rising YoY.

As endodontist volume holds up better than GP and other-specialty volume, the endodontist share of overall treatments has continued to grow year-over-year.

02

Specialty share gains are visible across subcategories.

Endodontists are gaining or maintaining share across the major endodontic subcategories, with the clearest share gains in retreatment and apicoectomy procedures.

03

Therapy: dominant in molars, gaining in premolars.

Endodontists continue to dominate molar therapy and have gained share in premolar therapy year-over-year.

04

Retreatment: modest endodontist share gains across all tooth types.

Endodontist share of retreatments has grown modestly across anterior, premolar, and molar between 2023 and 2025.

Fees keep climbing — 3% to 7% YoY across major subcategories, both in- and out-of-network.

01

Submitted dollars per treatment continue to grow.

Across the major endodontic subcategories, average in-network and out-of-network submitted dollars per treatment grew approximately 3% to 7% in both 2024 and 2025.

02

Pulp capping led the YoY fee growth.

Pulp capping showed the largest percentage increases in average submitted dollars per treatment, growing 6.5% in-network in 2024 and 5.7% in 2025.

03

Intraorifice barrier submitted charges are increasing.

Average submitted dollars per treatment for intraorifice barriers grew quarter-over-quarter.

04

Steady quarter-over-quarter growth across all major procedures.

Q4 2025 marks the highest dollar values of the analysis period across all major endodontic subcategories and procedures.

01 Group practice size matters: large groups gained share while solo practices declined steepest.

Solo practices (1 location) declined -3.1% in 2024 and -5.2% in 2025; large groups (50+) were the only segment to grow in 2024 (+2.7%) before a -0.9% softening in 2025. Solo-practice share fell ~1.6 percentage points since 2023, shifting primarily to 50+ groups.

02 Newly added CDT codes are not yet reflected.

An updated workbook and supplemental analysis covering recently-added CDT codes will be provided separately. This includes the following miscellaneous codes: D2955, D9310, D0170, D0220, D0230, D0364, D0380, D0460, D0461, D2950

03 All charts display projection ranges (Min and Max).

Year-over-year changes referenced in commentary are calculated using the midpoint of the Min/Max projection range; the actual figure falls between the two values shown in each chart.

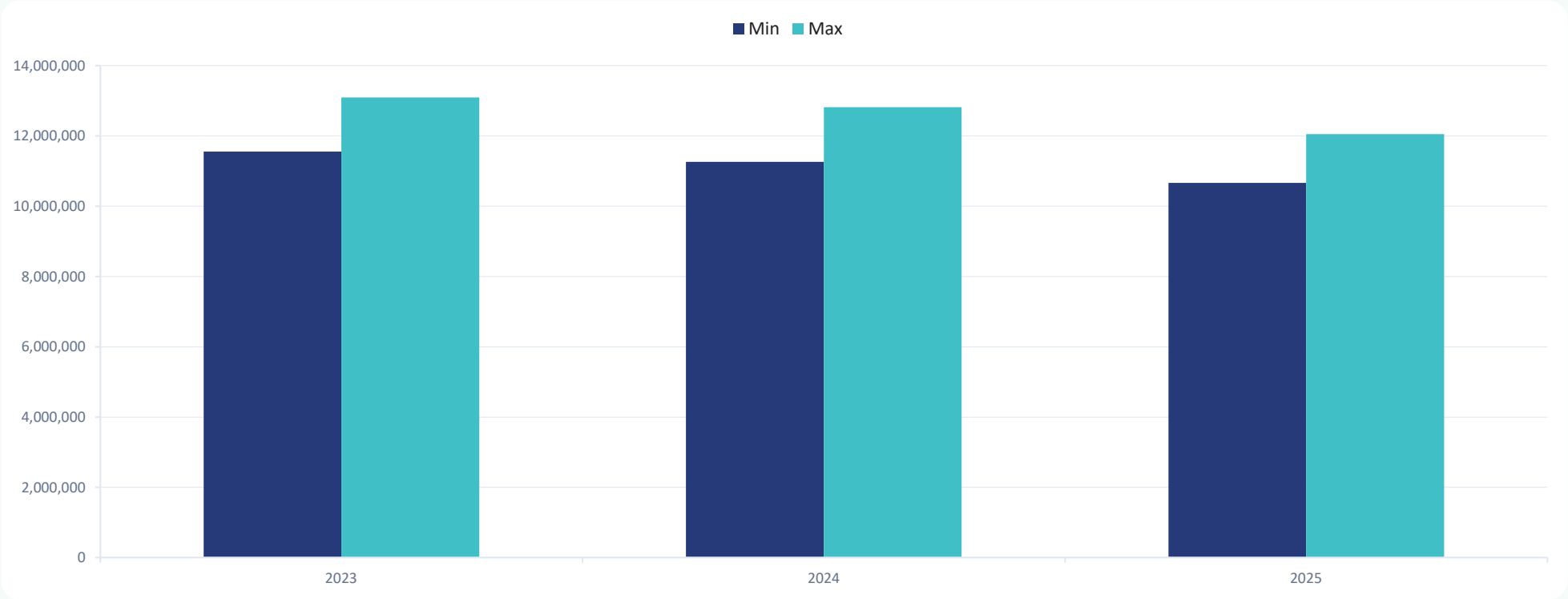

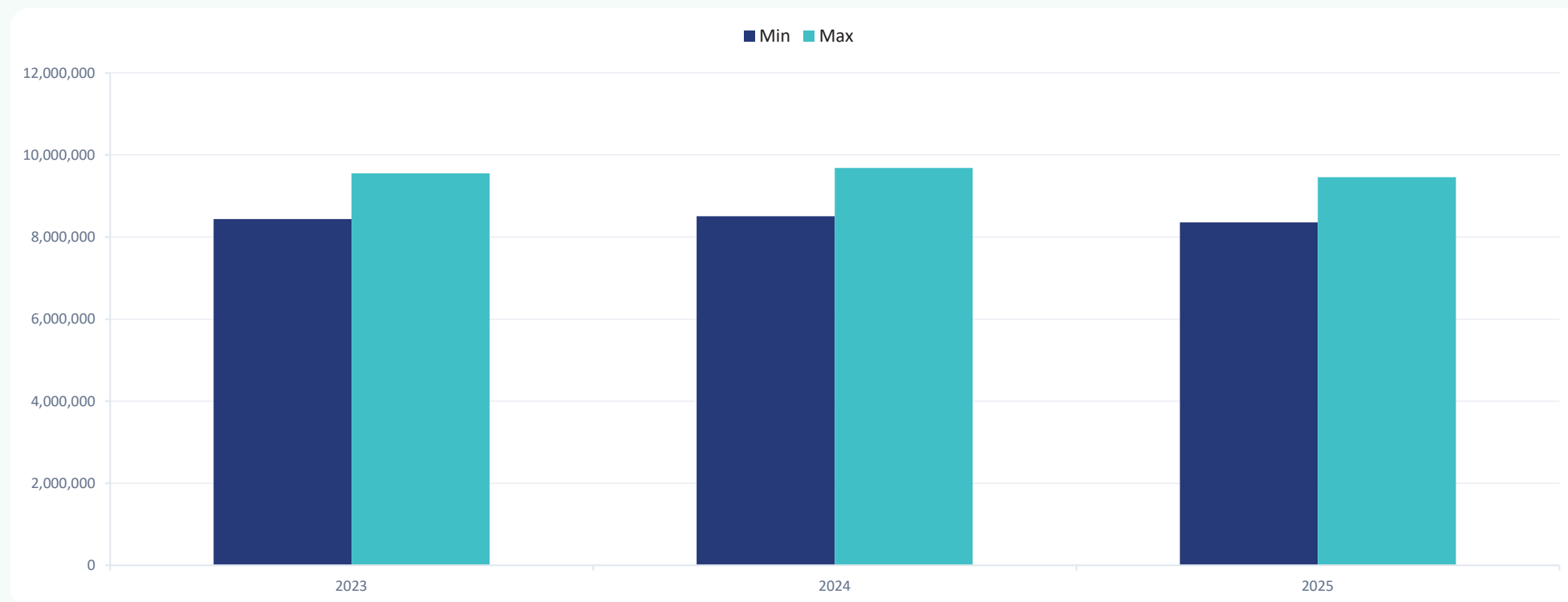

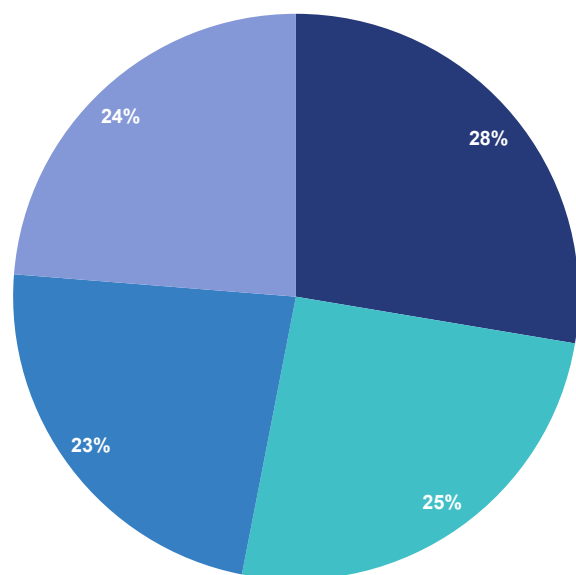

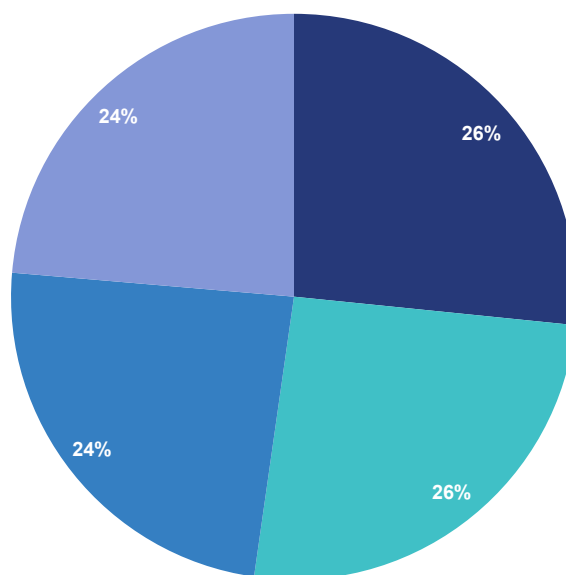

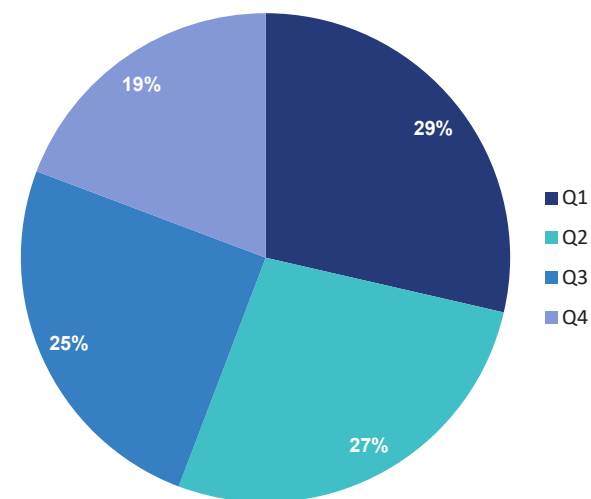

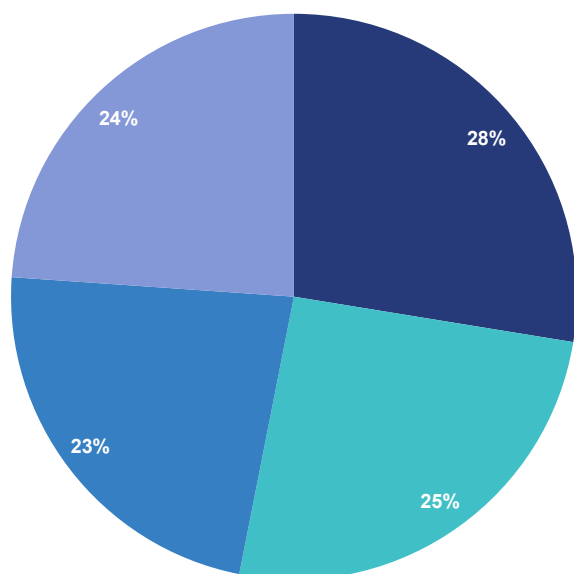

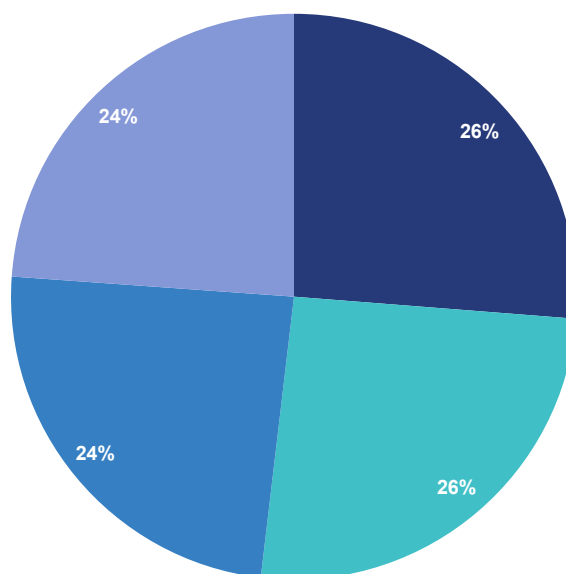

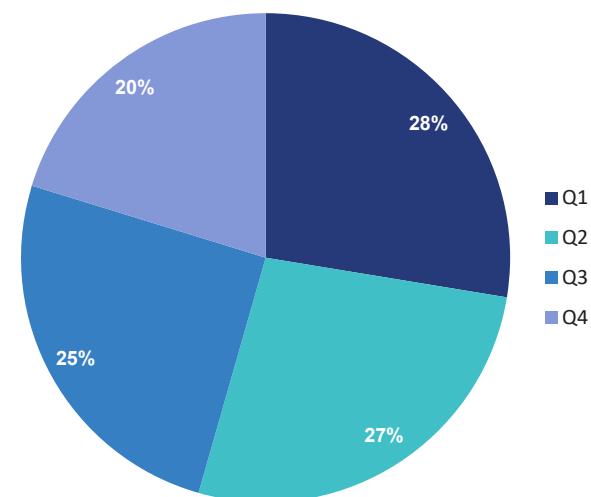

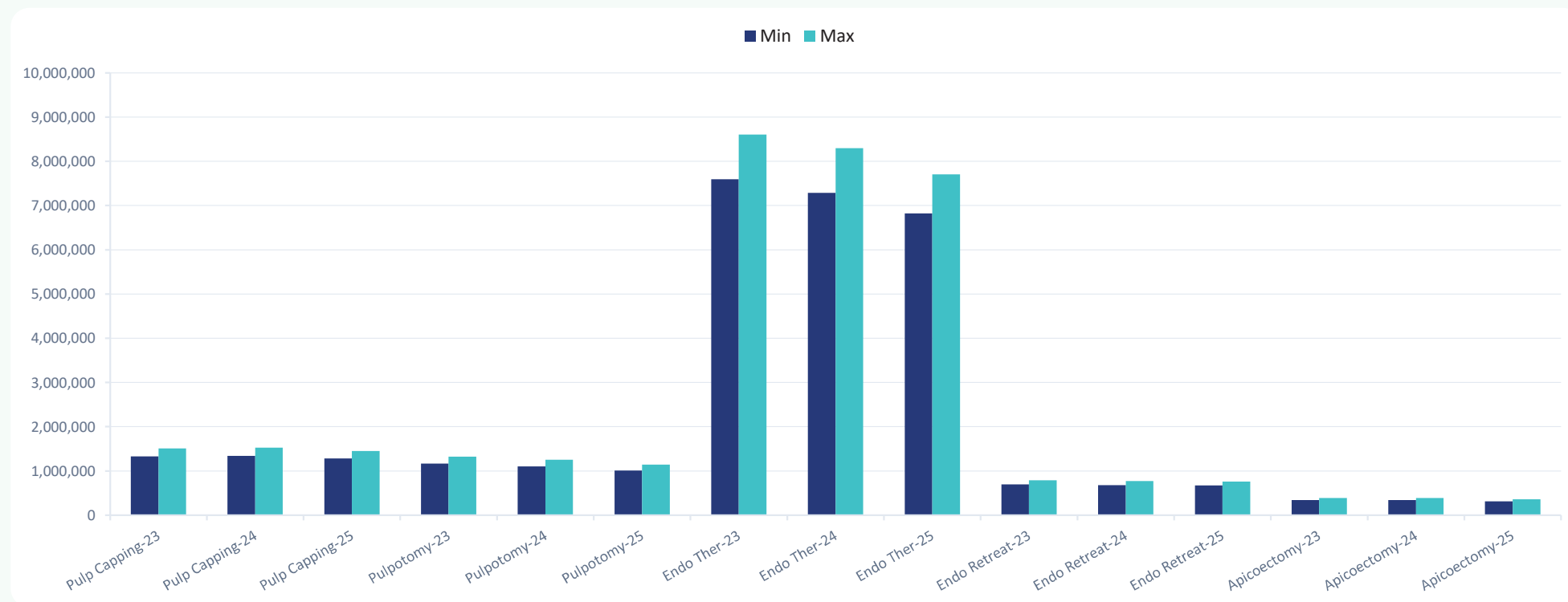

Largest Volume Subcategories — 2023 to 2025

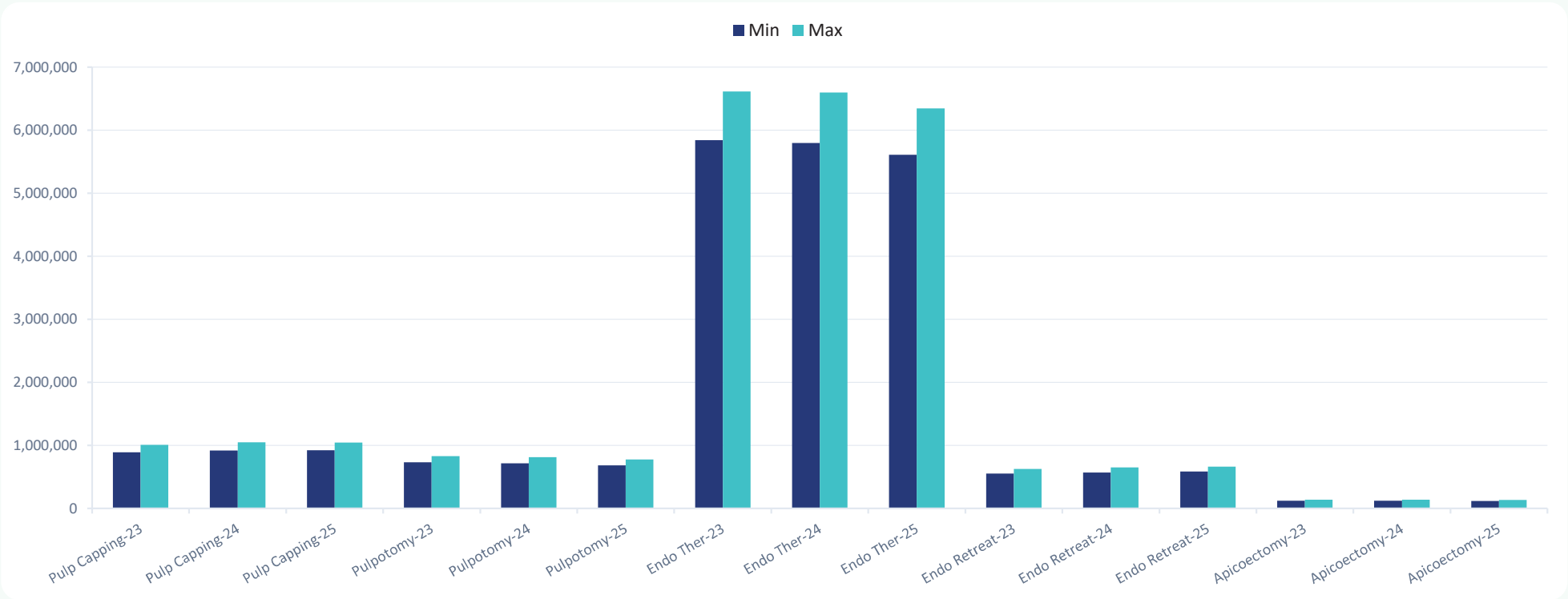


- Endodontic therapy, retreatment, and apicoectomy treatment volumes declined year-over-year in both 2024 and 2025.
- Pulp capping was essentially flat in 2024 (+1.0%) before declining in 2025 (-4.6%); pulpotomy declined in both years.
- Endodontic retreatment had the smallest declines among major subcategories (-1.8% in 2024, -1.4% in 2025).

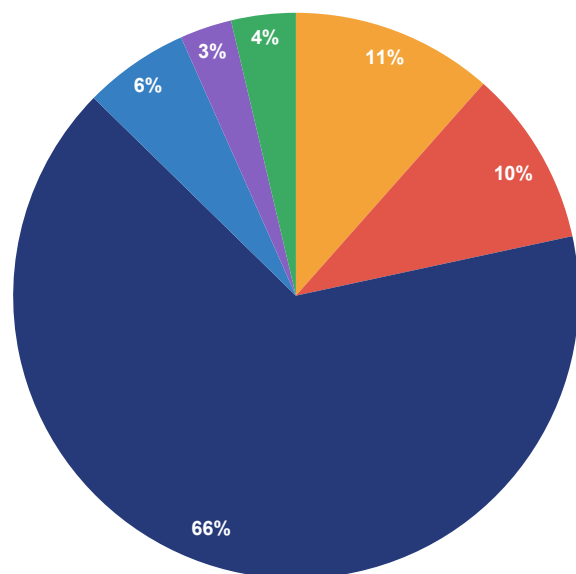

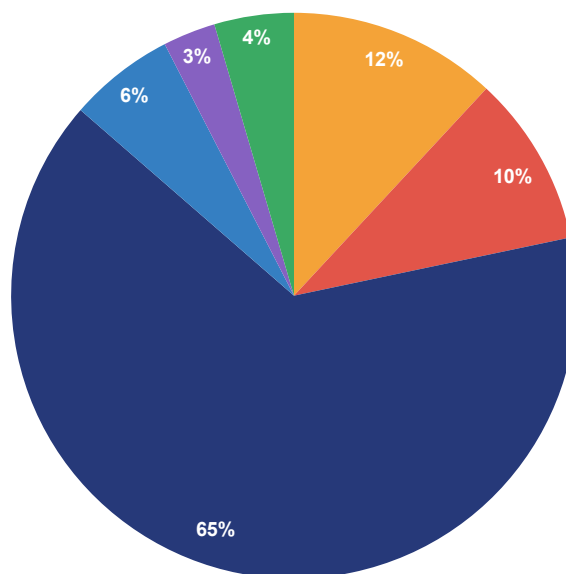

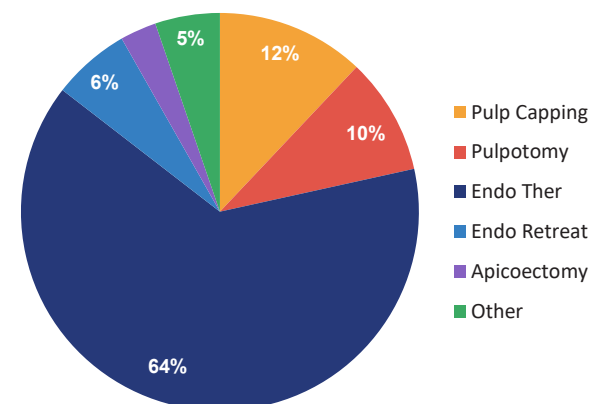

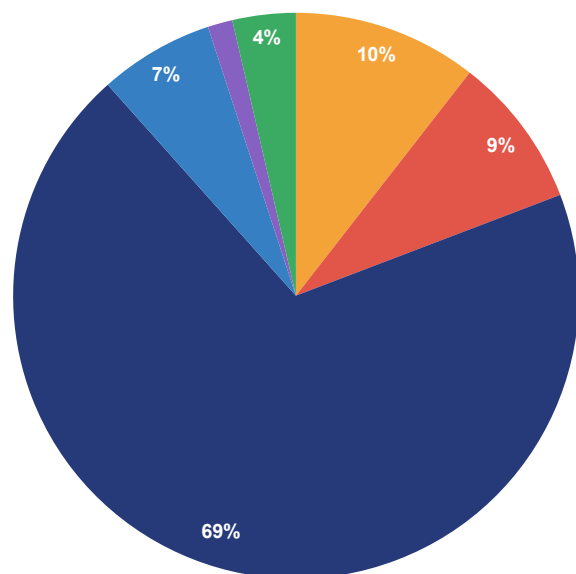

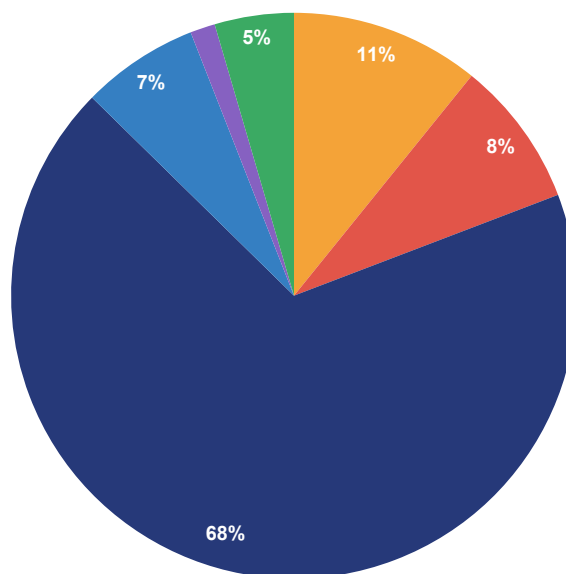

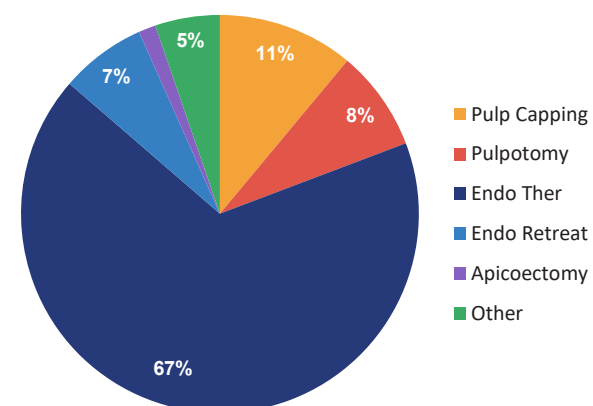

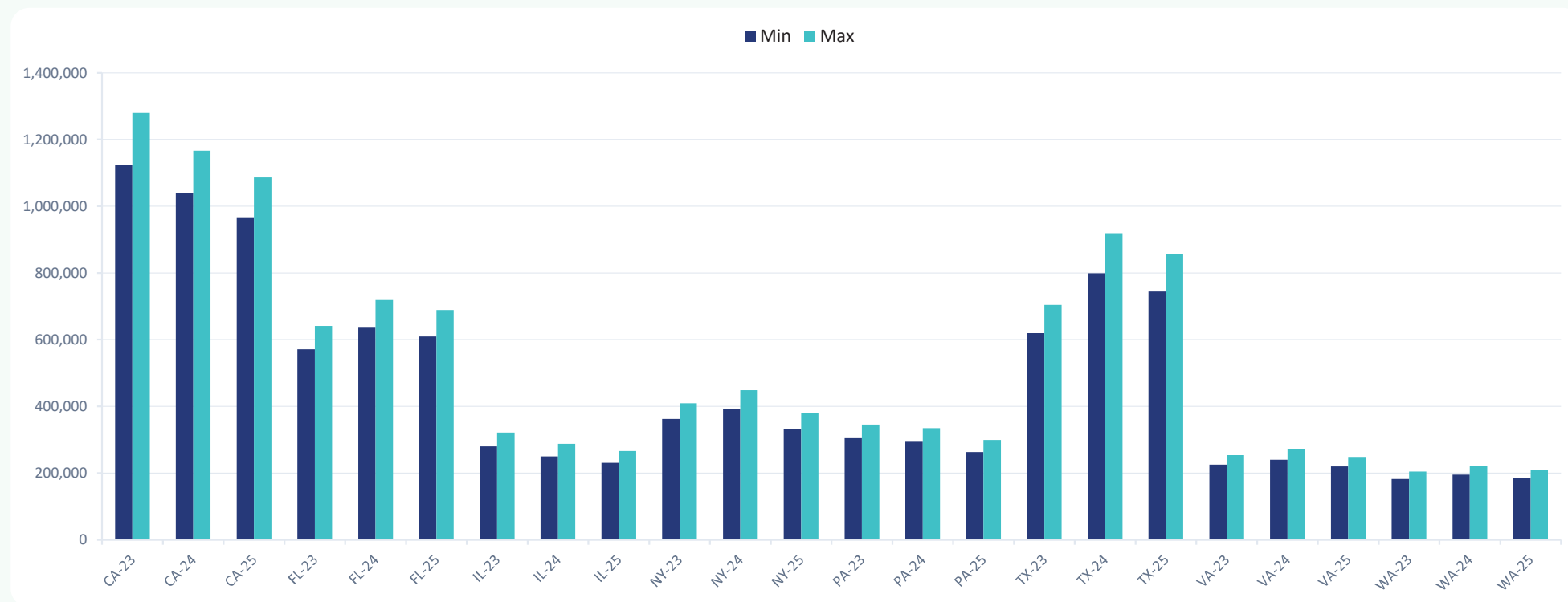

Largest States by 2025 Volume — 2023 to 2025

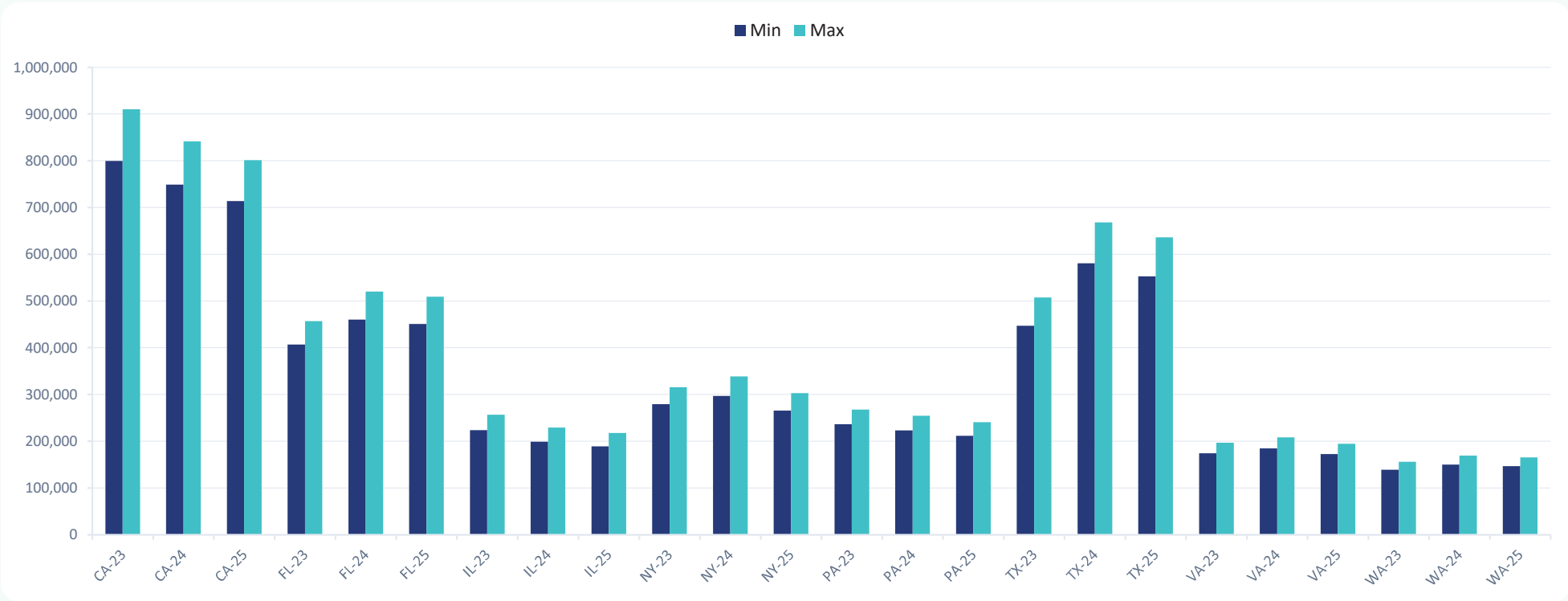


- All eight largest states declined in 2025, with declines ranging from -4.2% (Florida) to -15.2% (New York).
- 2024 patterns were mixed: Texas (+29.8%), Florida (+11.8%), and New York (+9.1%) showed strong growth; California (-8.2%) and Illinois (-10.5%) declined.
- State-level shifts reflect both population dynamics and updated NADP state-level projections.

Largest States by 2025 Volume — 2023 to 2025

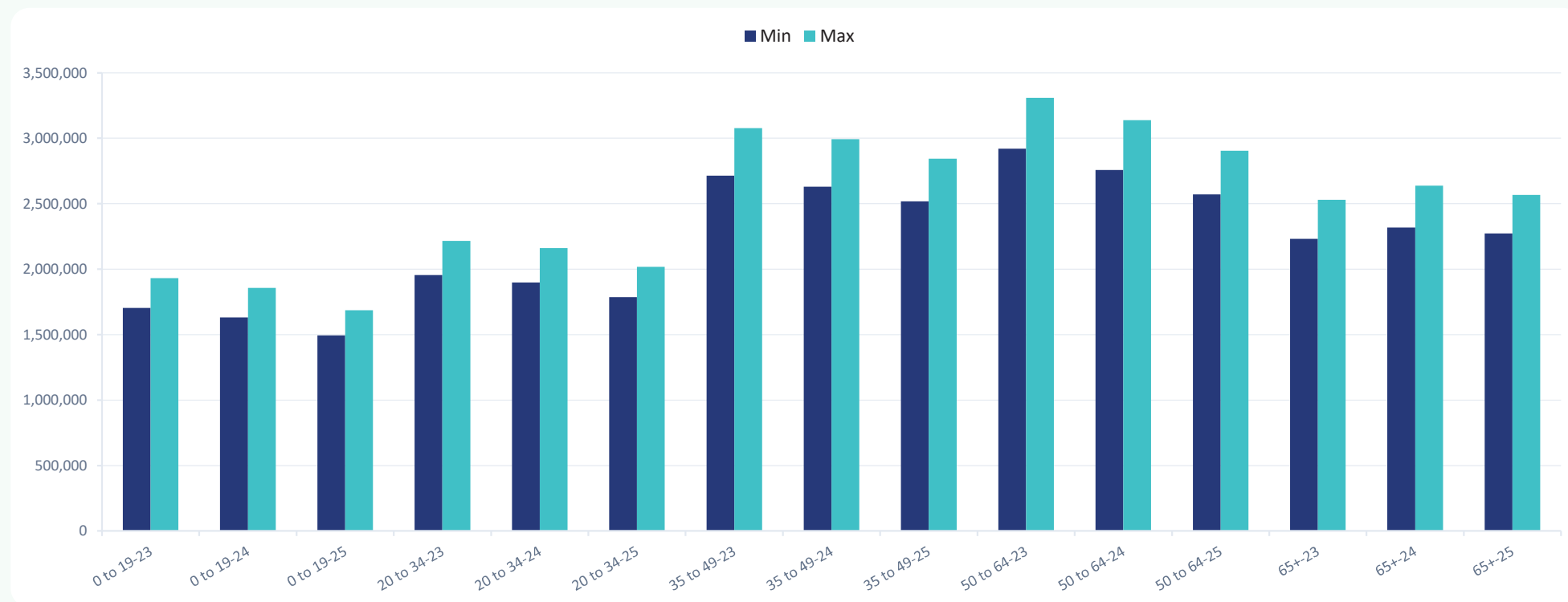


- Patient volume trends by state largely follow treatment volume trends — broad 2025 declines following mixed 2024 patterns.

Patient Age — 2023 to 2025

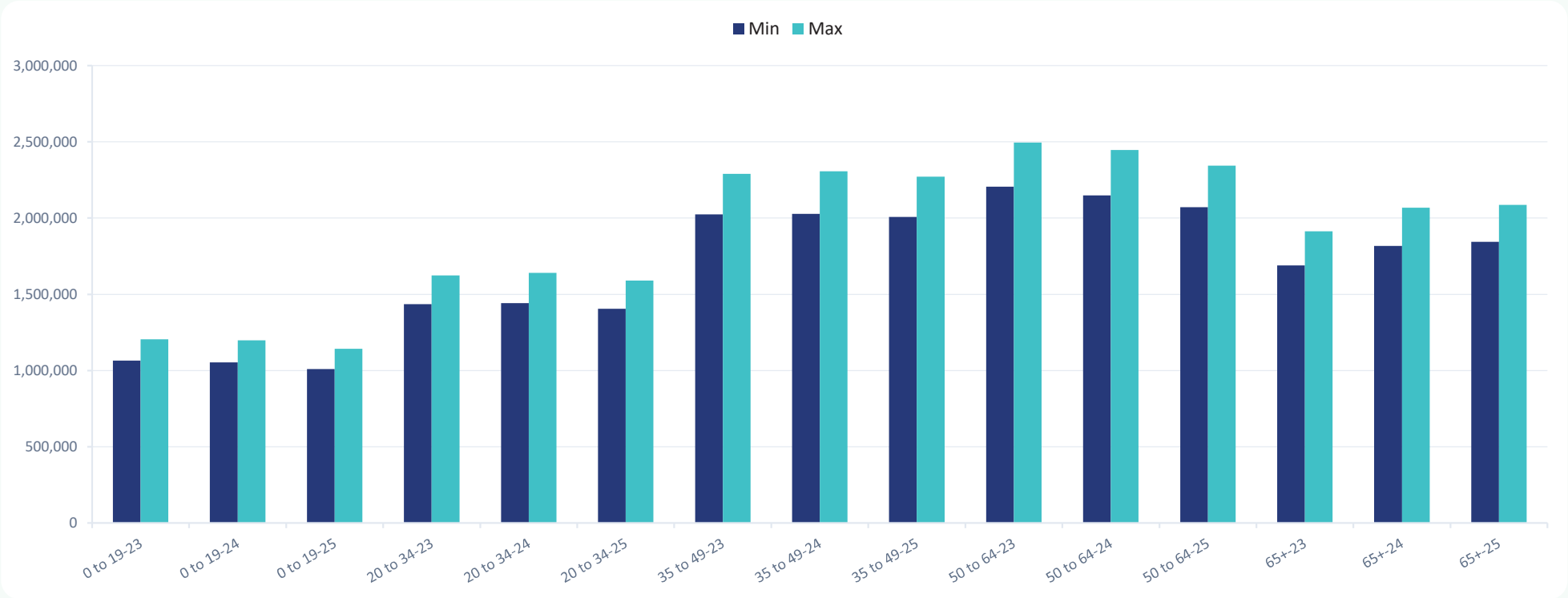


- Patients age 65+ were the only group with treatment growth in 2024 (+4.1%); they declined modestly in 2025 (-2.4%).
- All other age groups declined in both years, with the steepest declines among 0-19 (-4.0% in 2024, -8.9% in 2025) and 50-64 (-5.3%, -7.2%).

Patient Age — 2023 to 2025



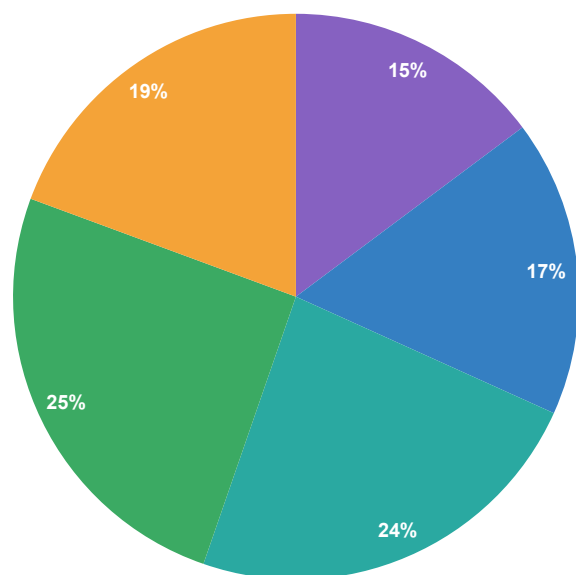

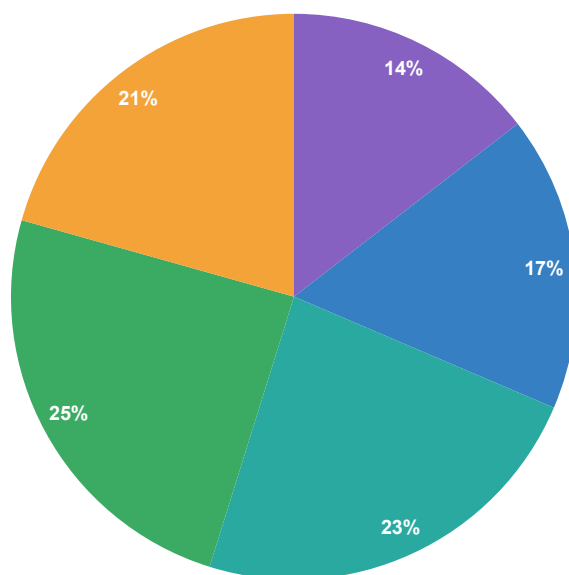

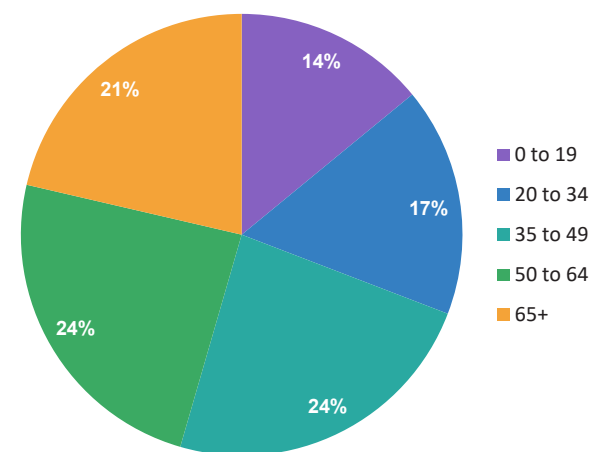

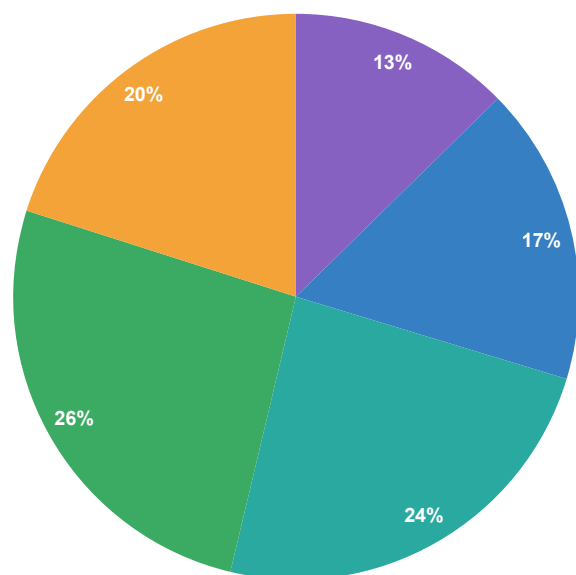

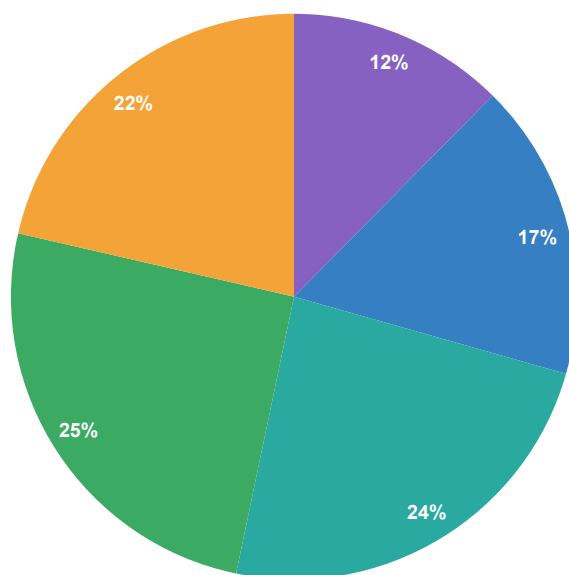

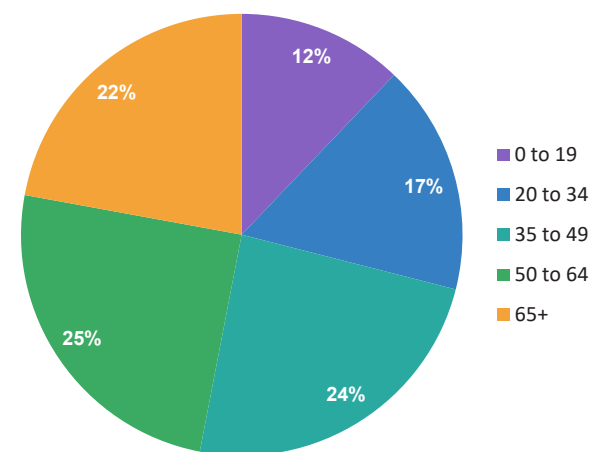

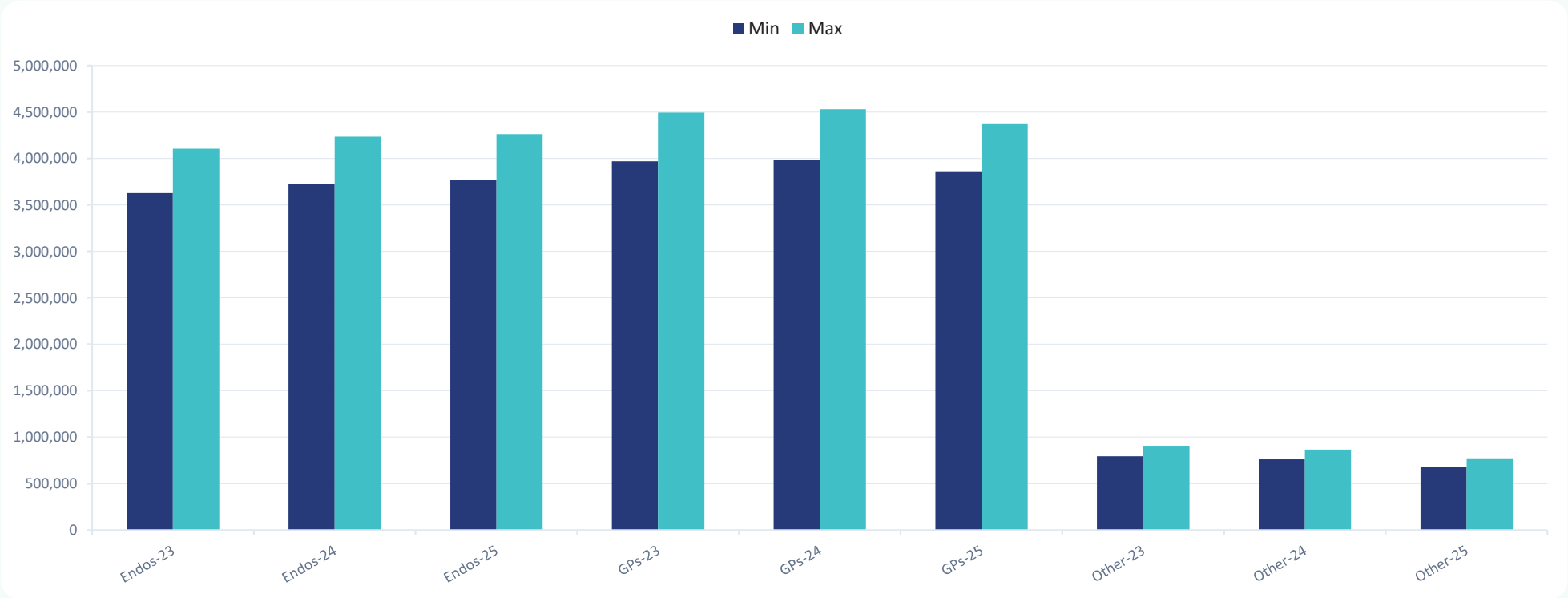


- Endodontists have shown the greatest resilience: -0.7% in 2024 and -2.0% in 2025.
- GP-performed treatment declined more meaningfully (-2.5% in 2024, -7.0% in 2025), and 'other' specialty volume declined steeply (-6.5%, -13.7%).

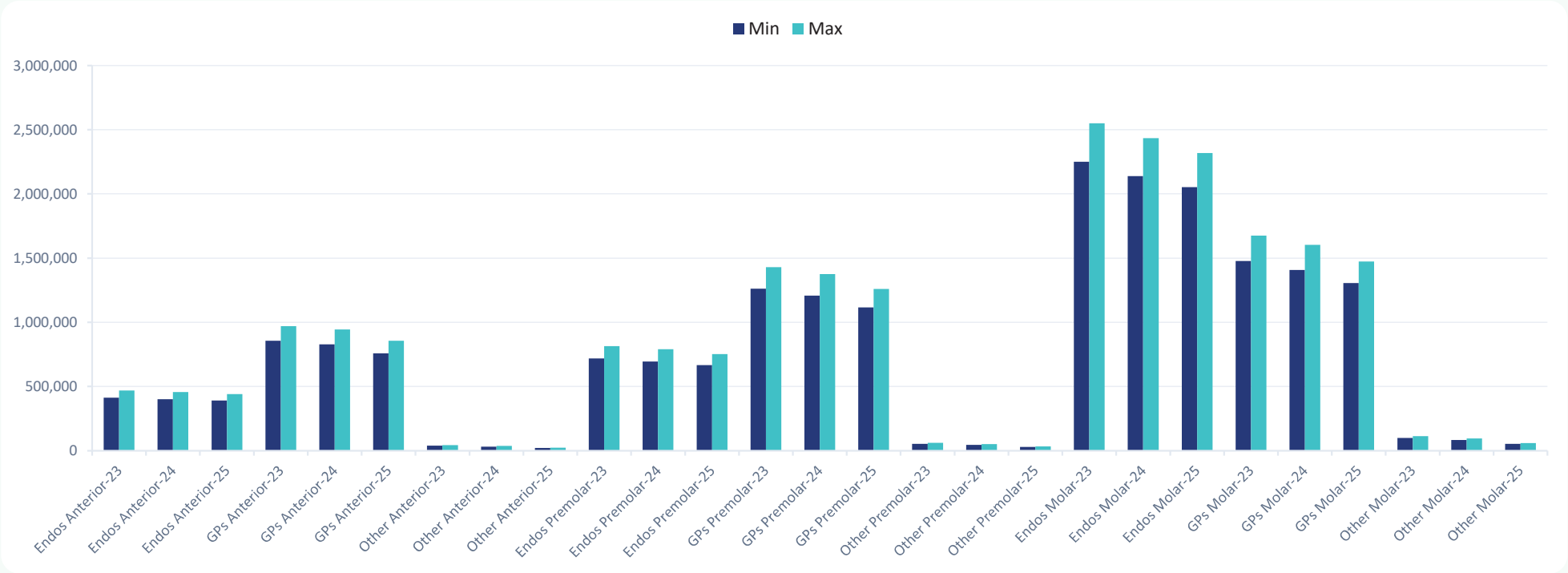

Provider Specialty by Tooth Type — 2023 to 2025

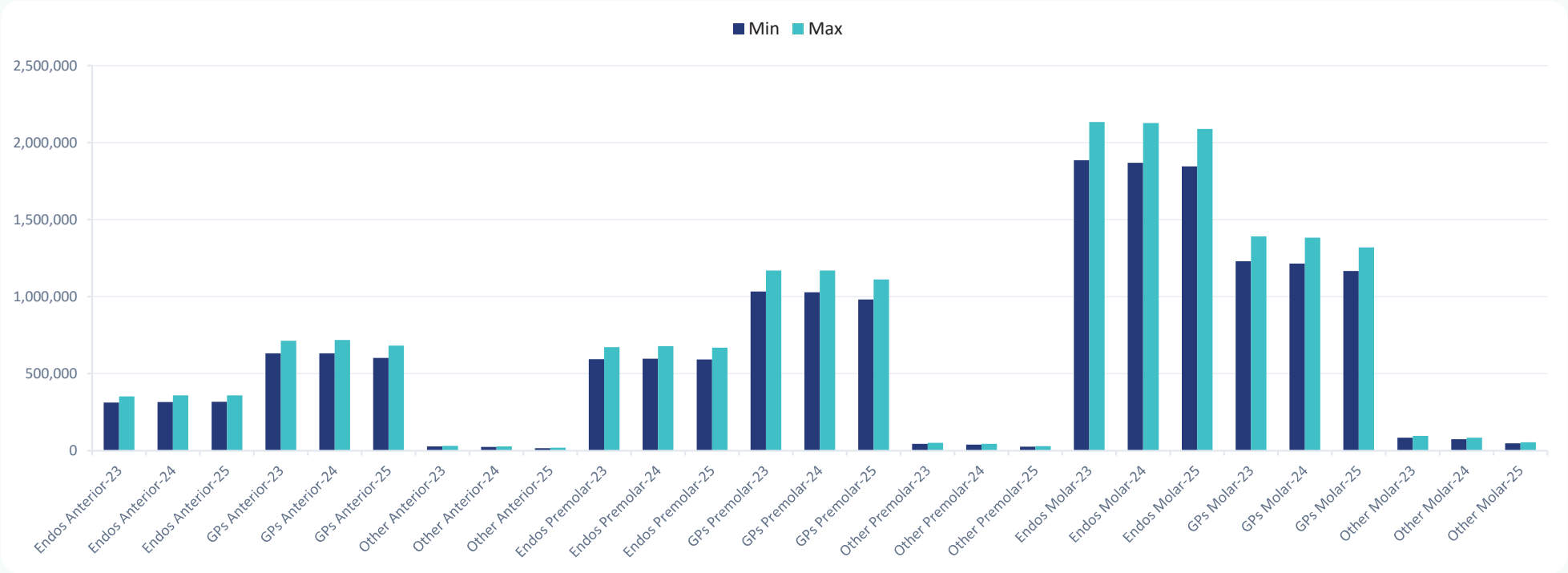


- Endodontic therapy treatment volumes declined across all tooth types in both years; declines were generally smaller for endodontists than for GPs or other specialties.

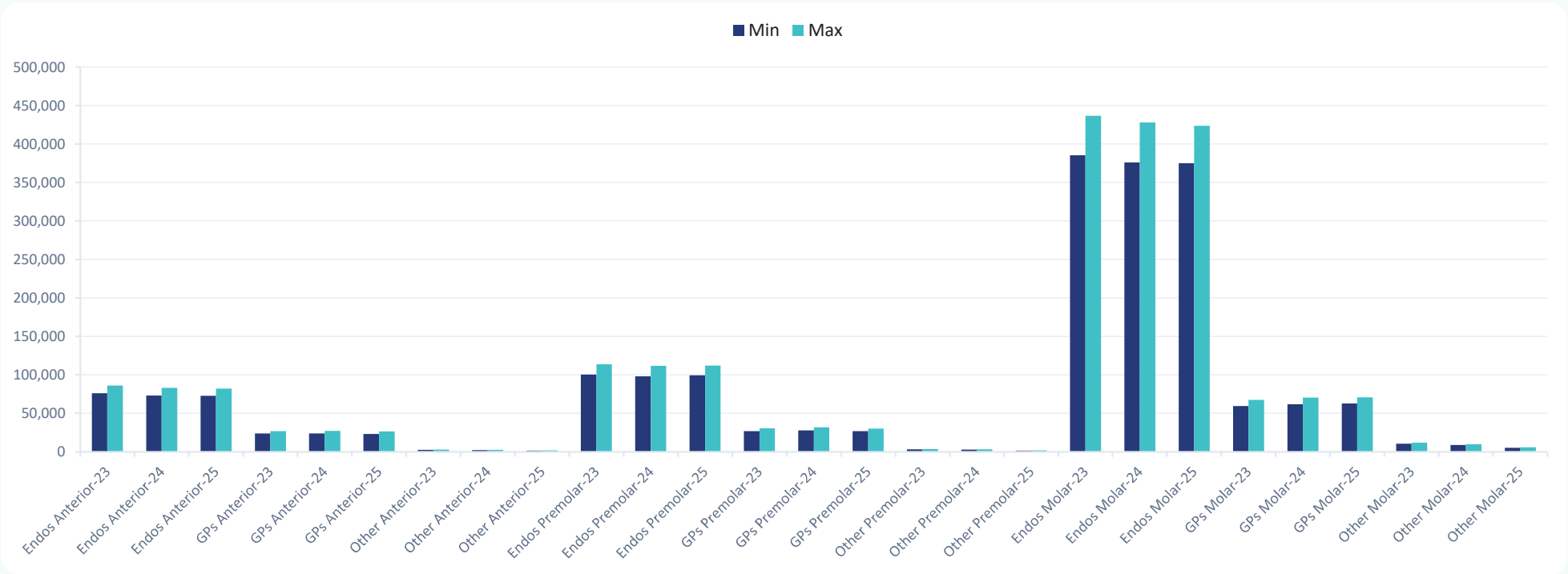

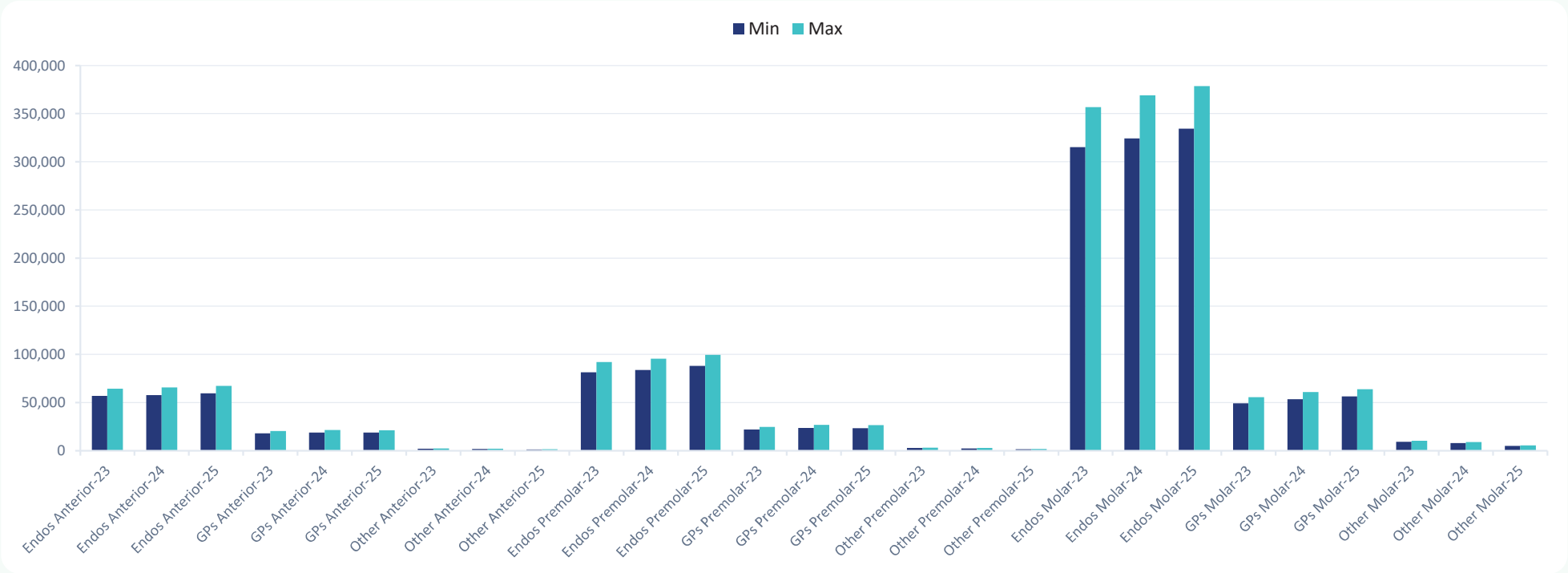

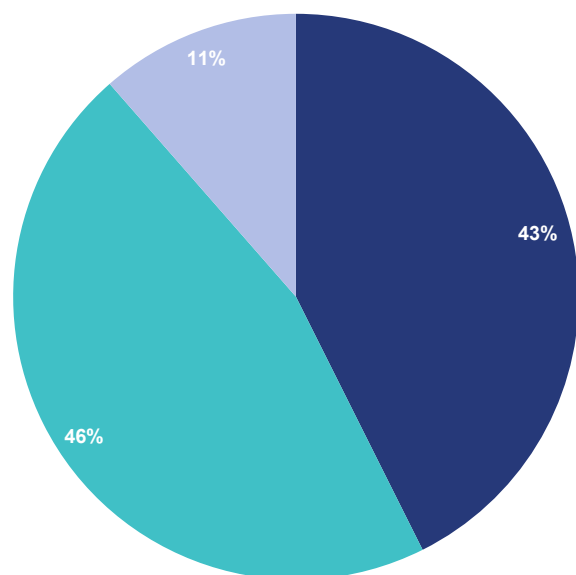

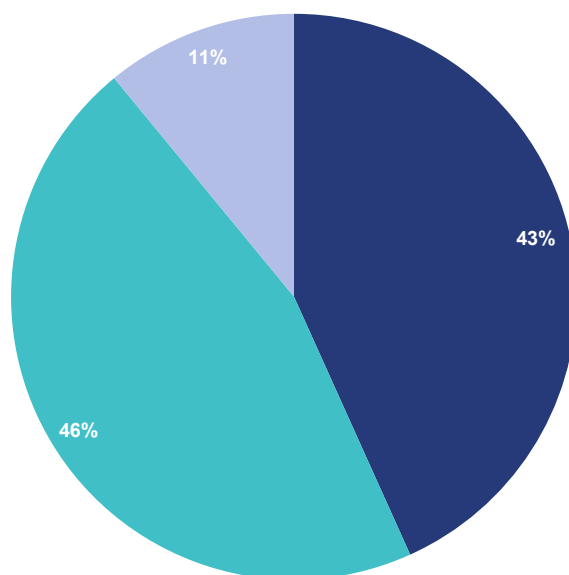

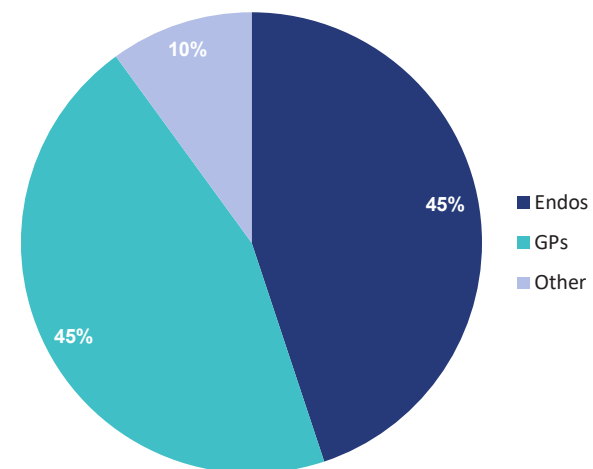

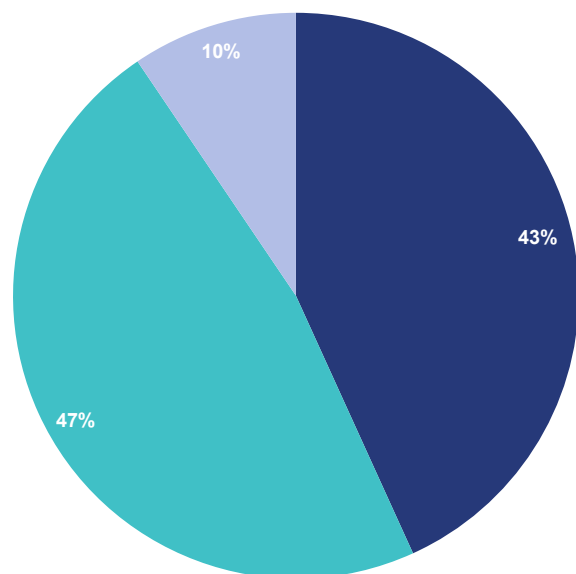

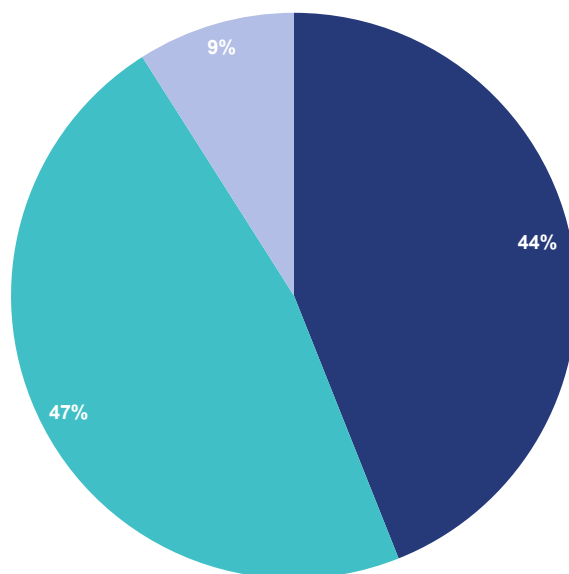

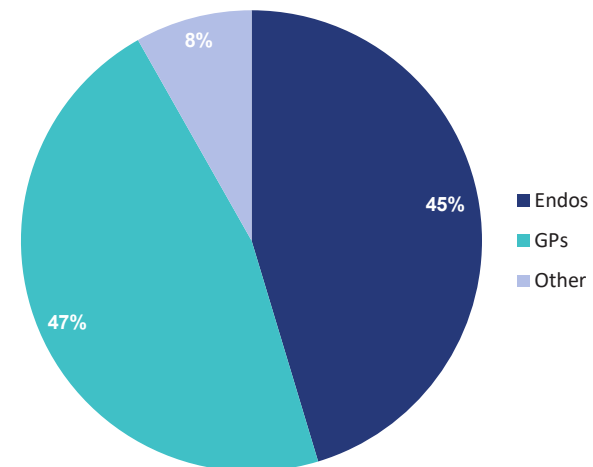

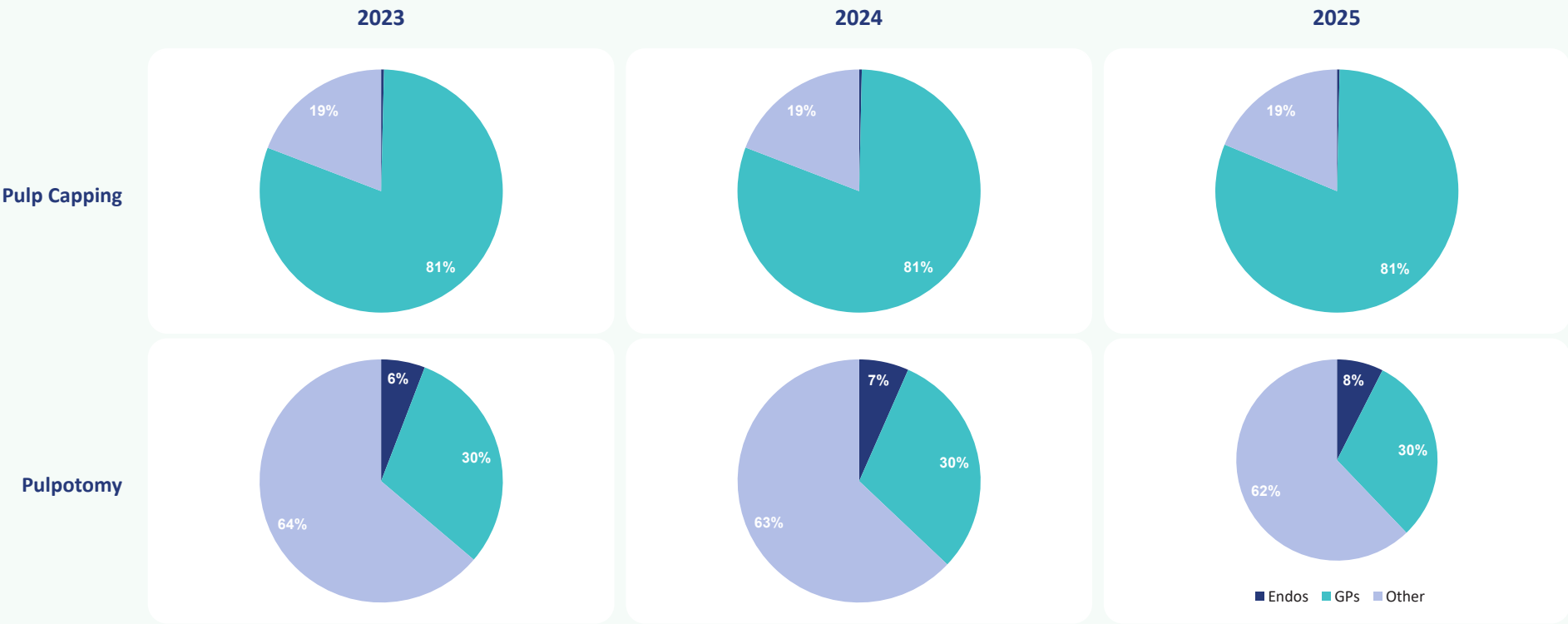

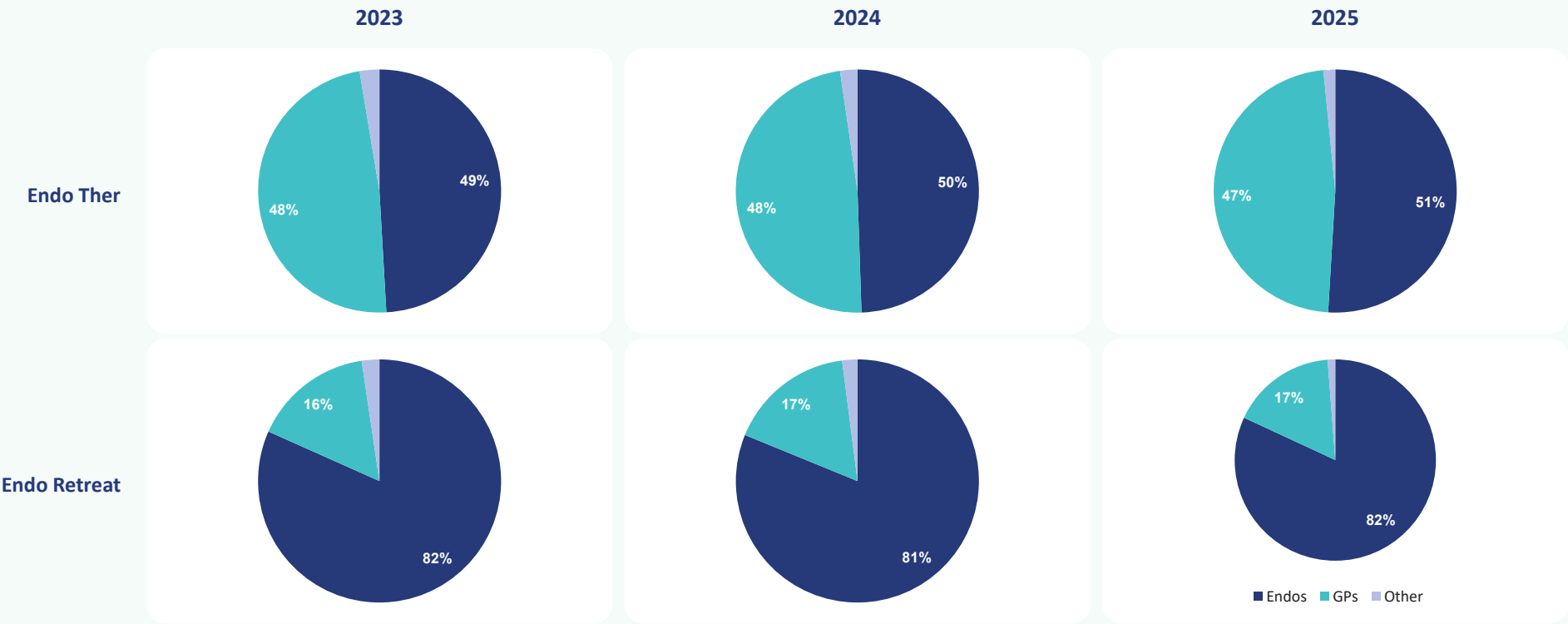

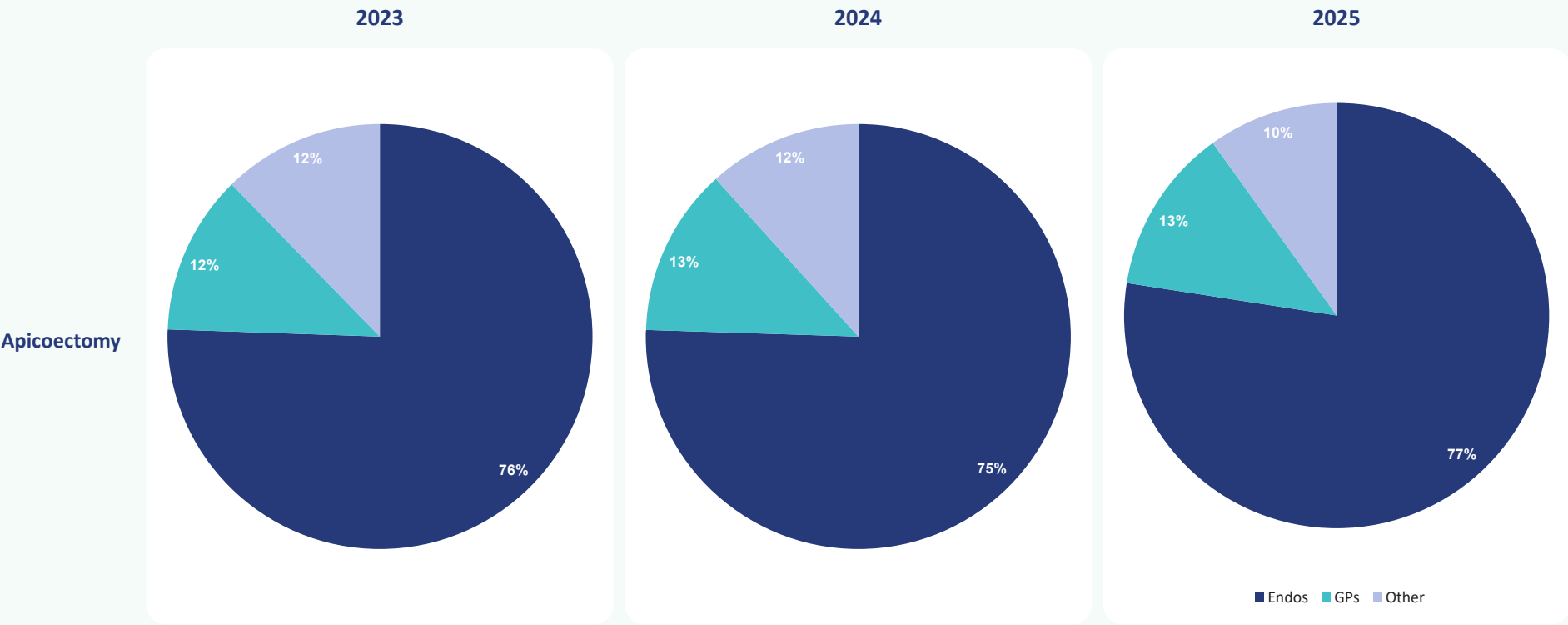

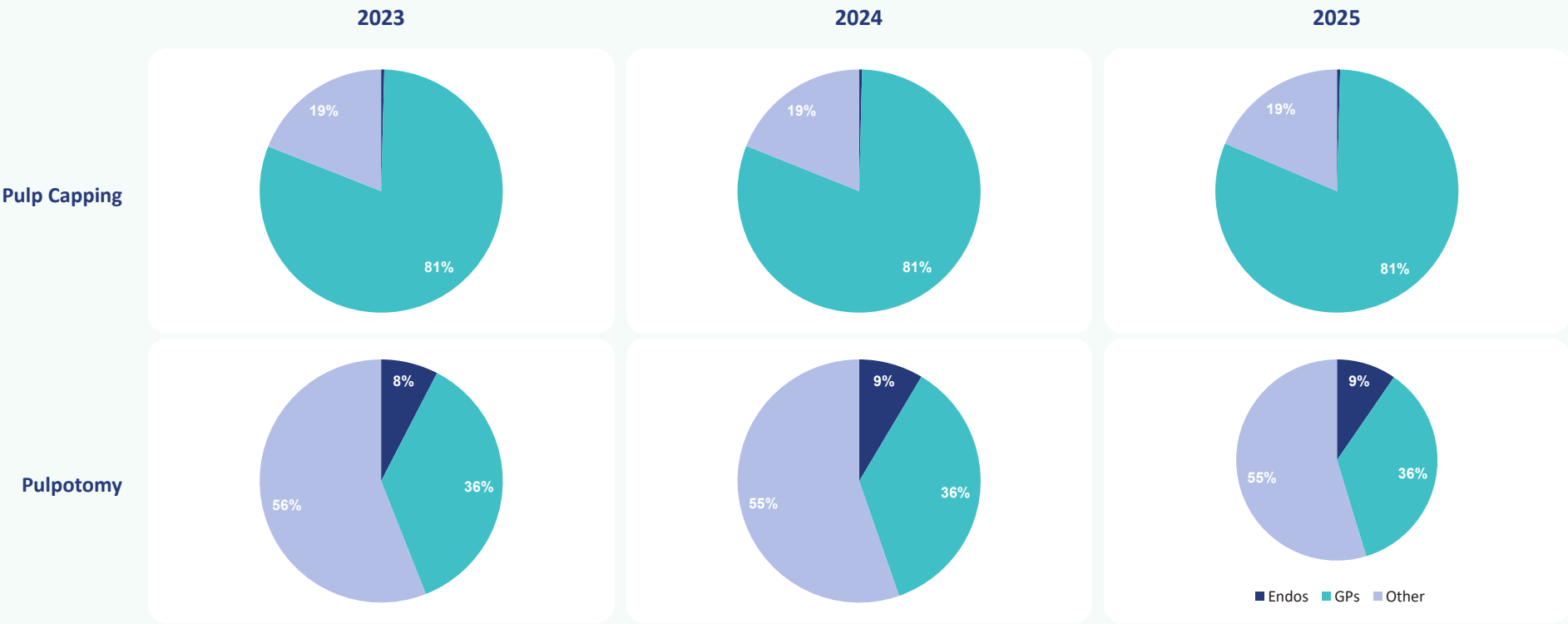

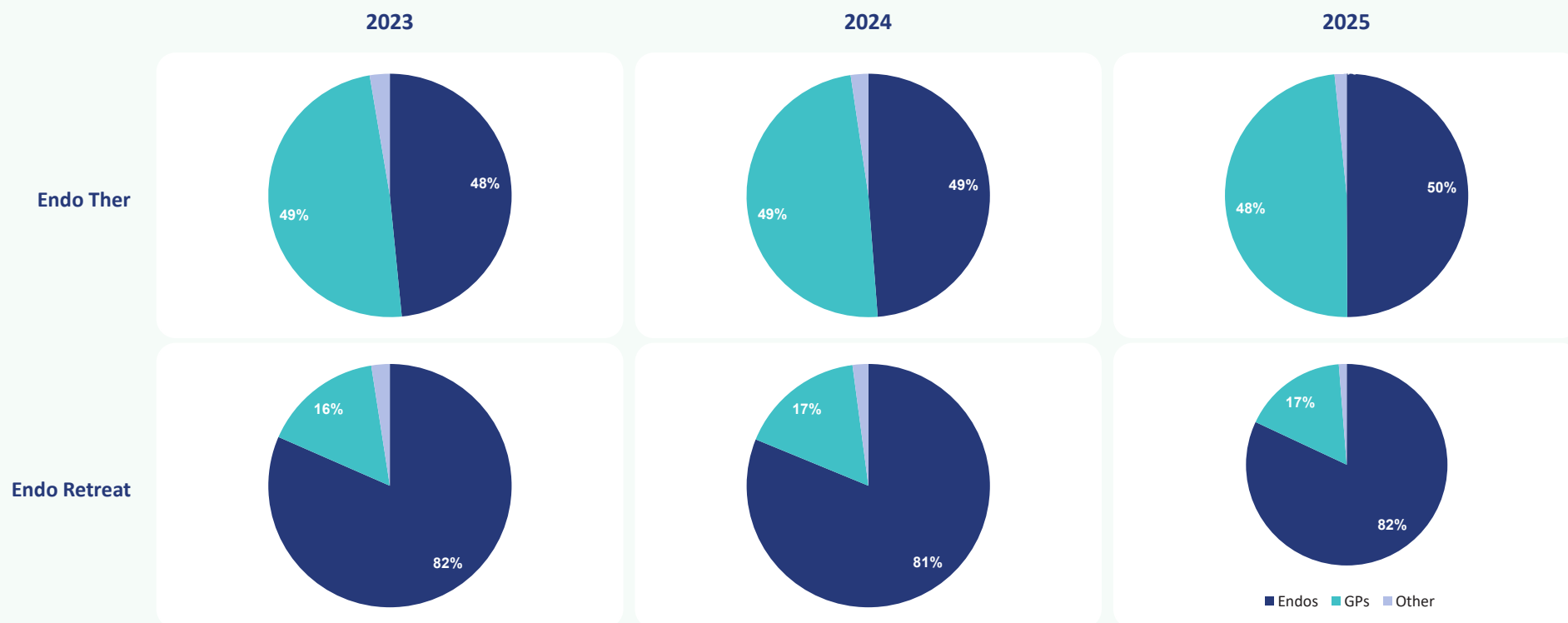

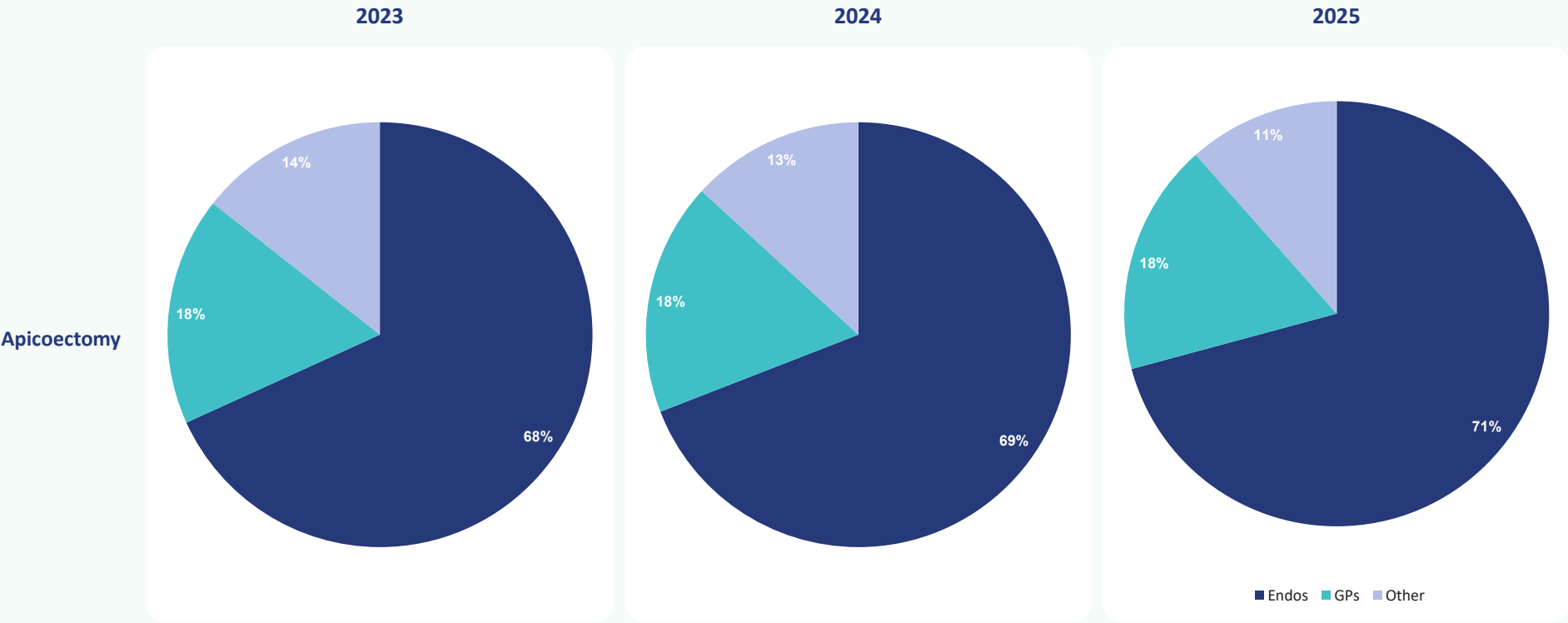

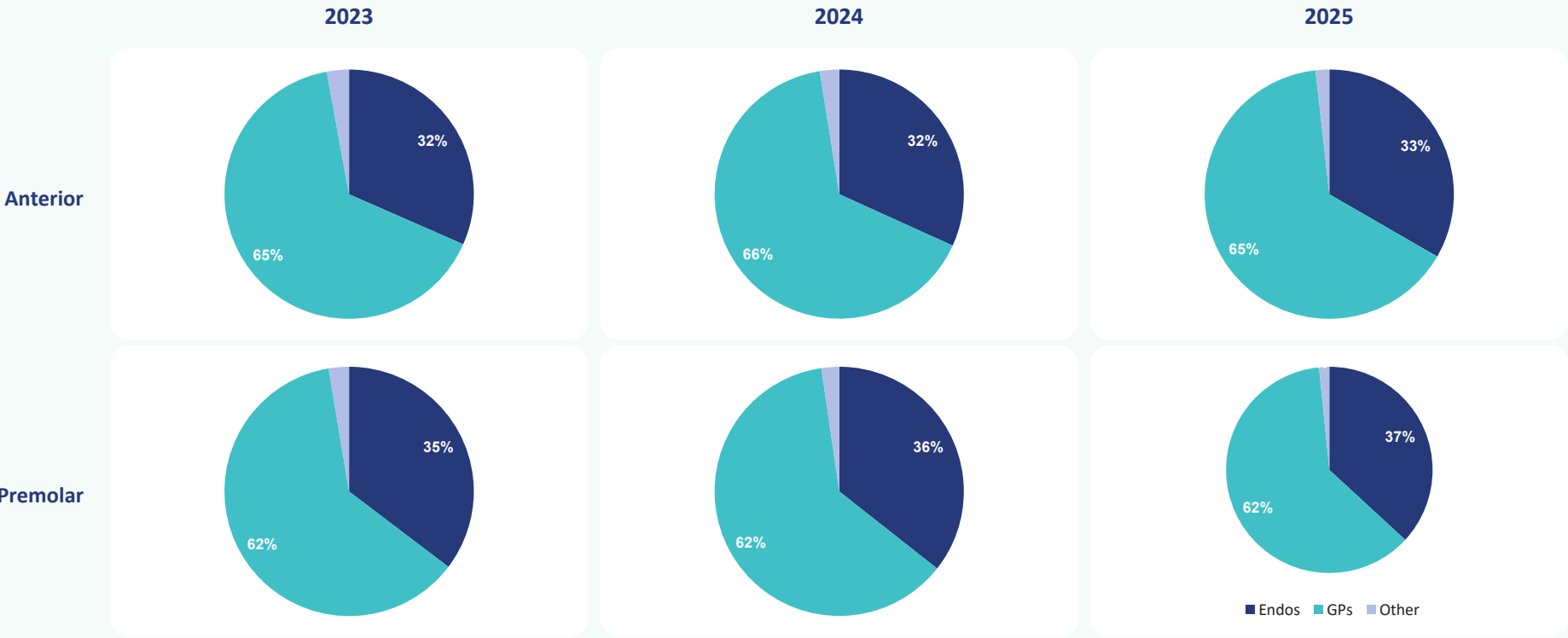

Tooth Type by Provider Specialty — 2023 to 2025 (1 of 2)

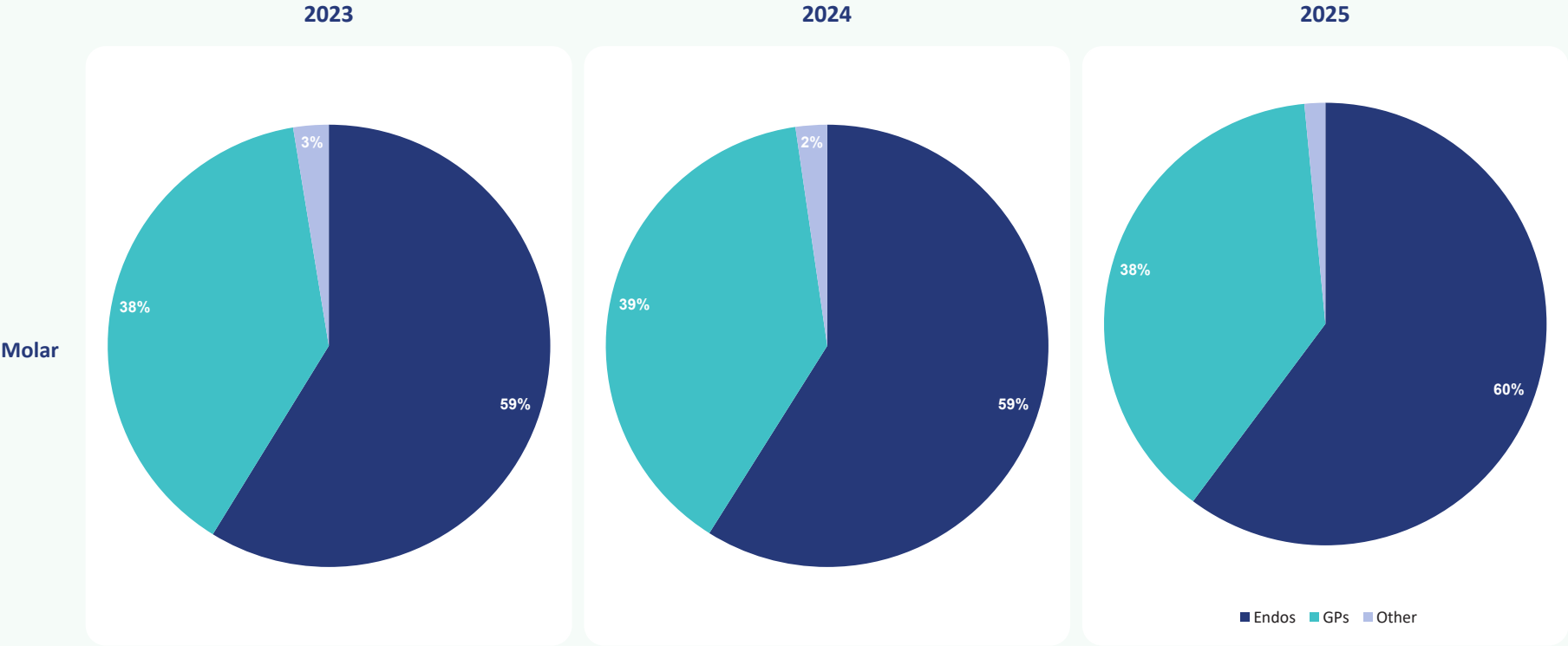

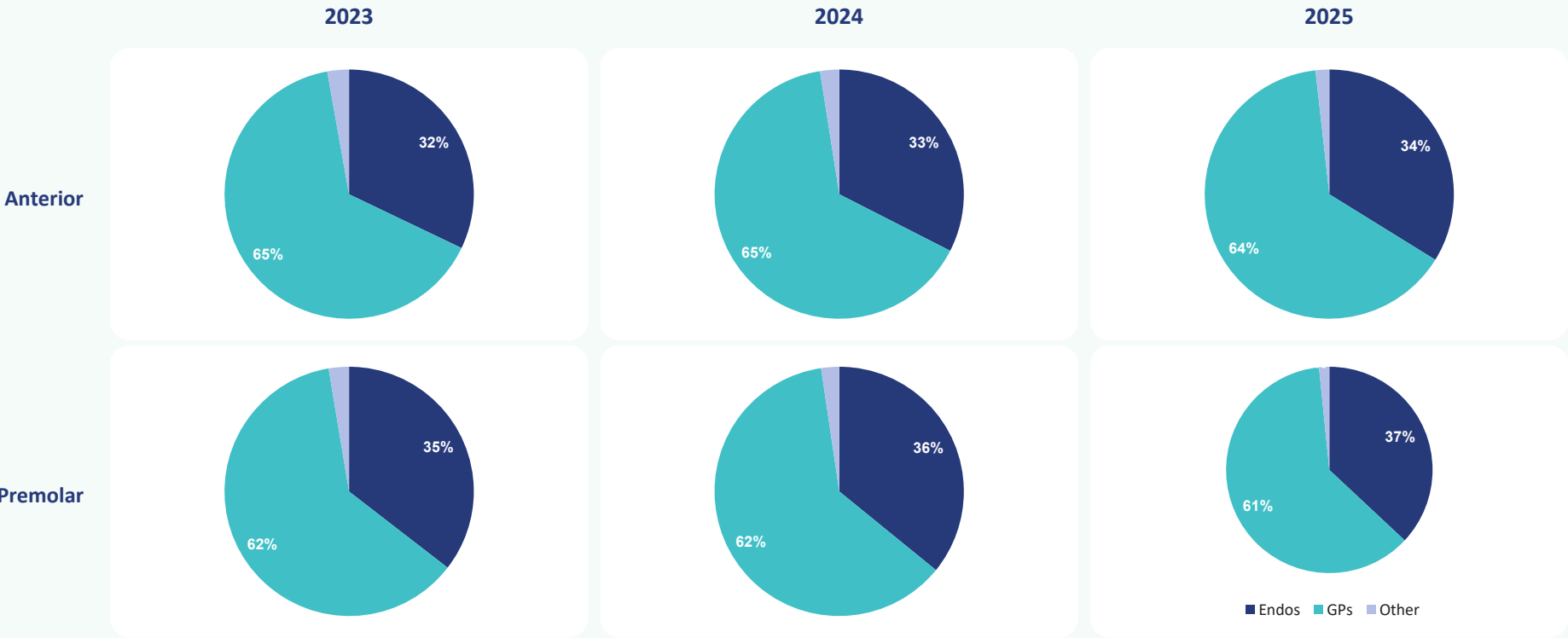

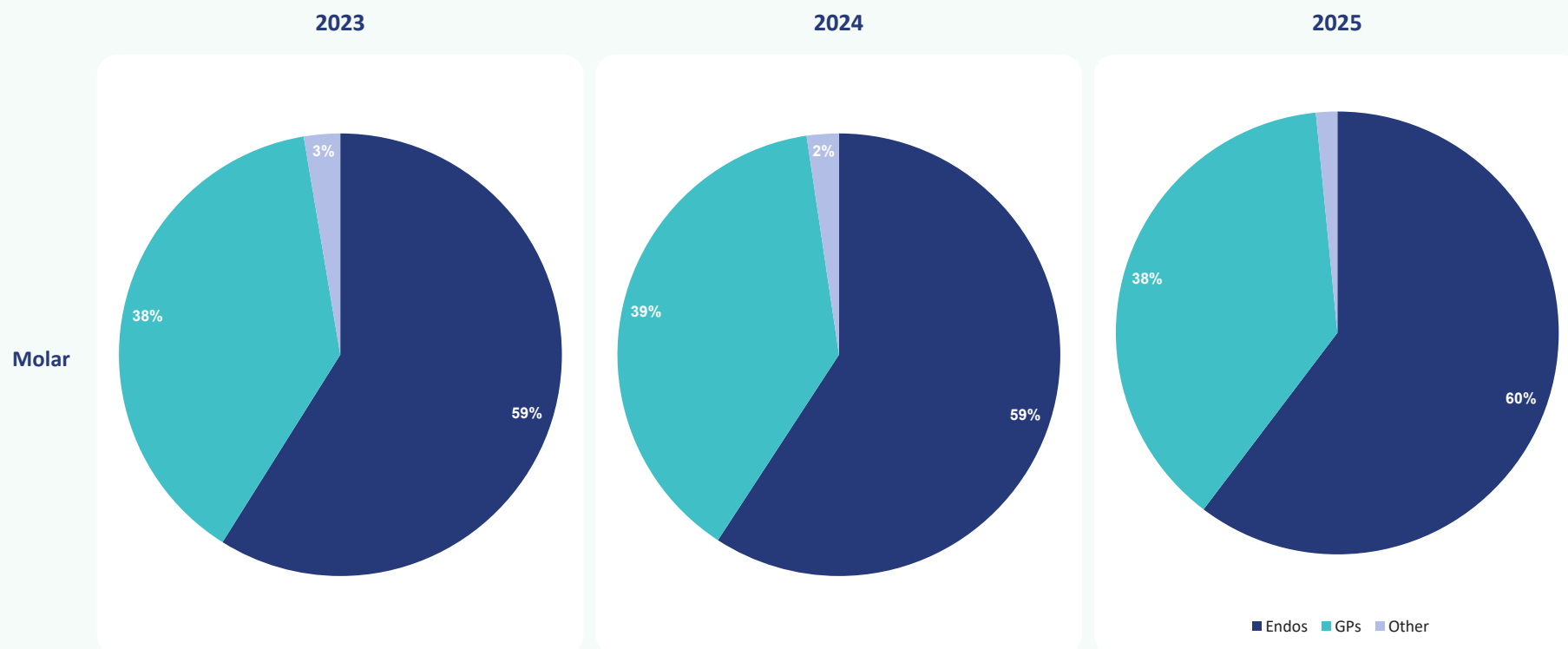

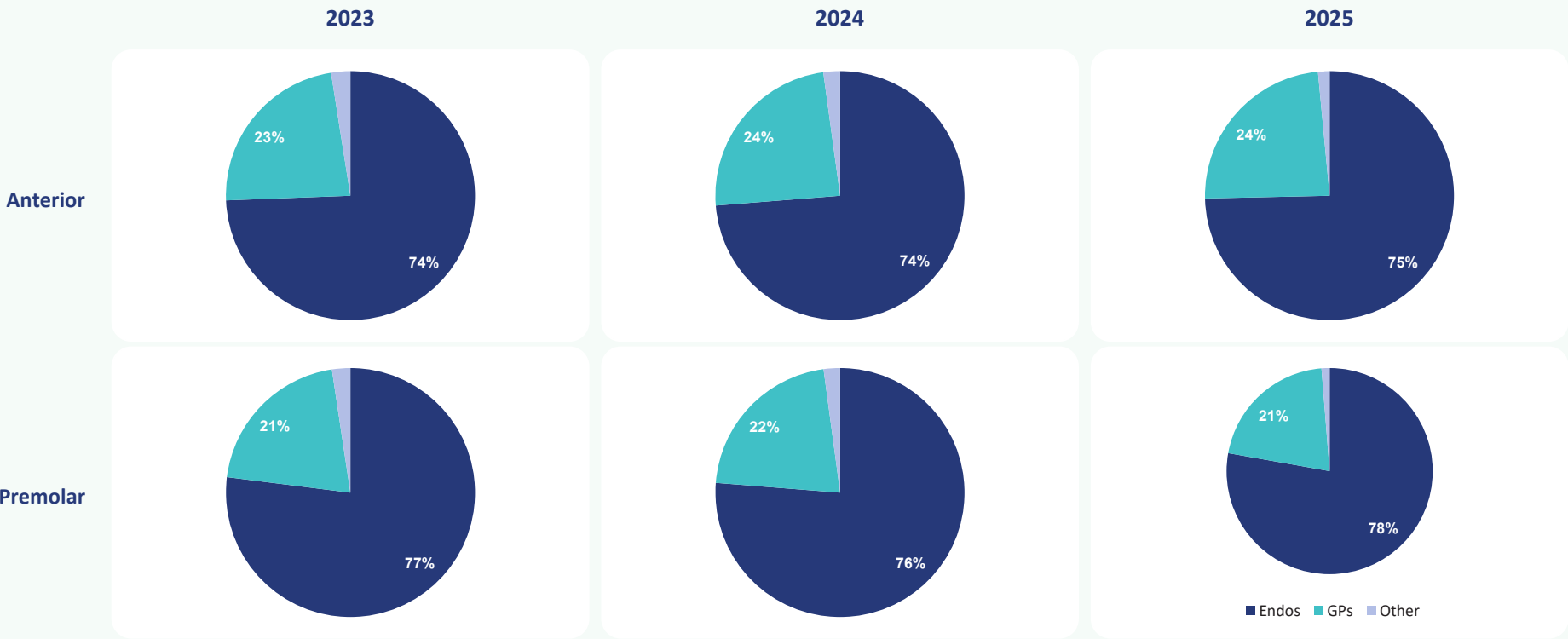

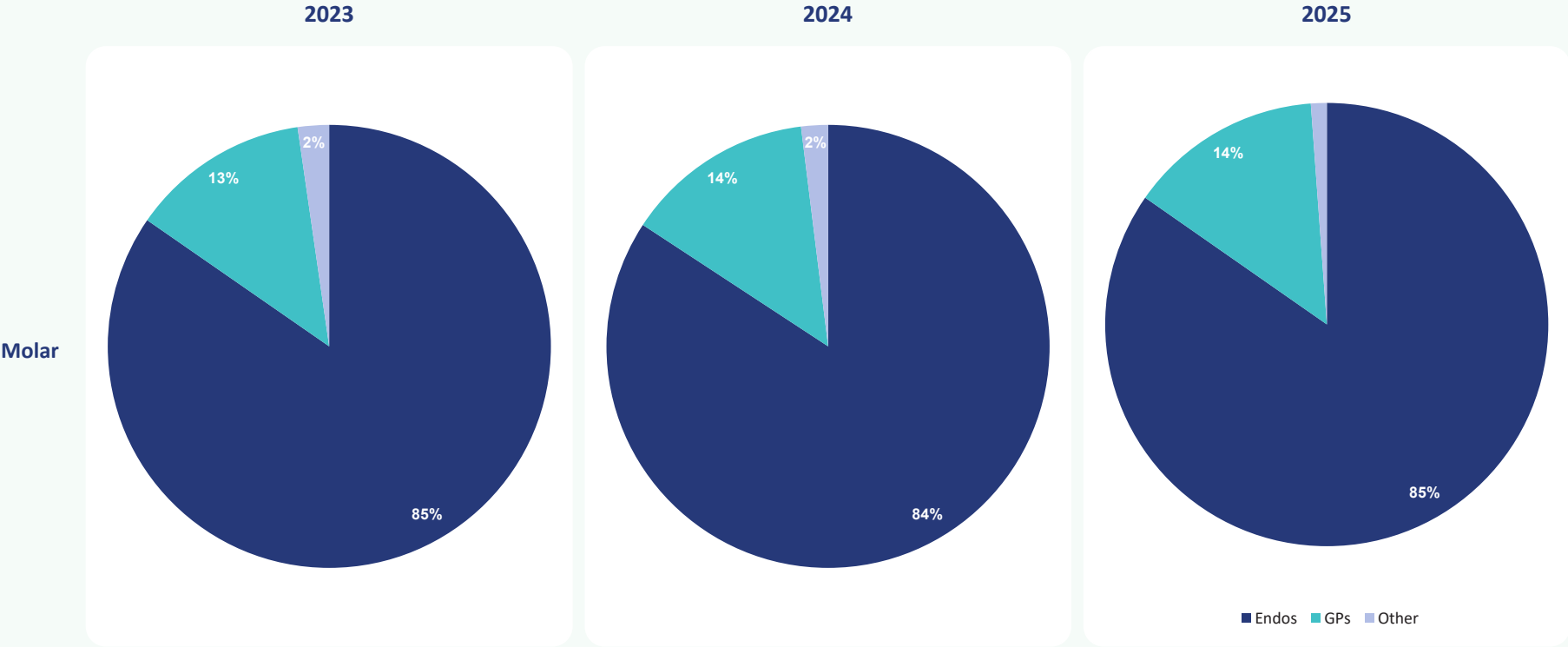

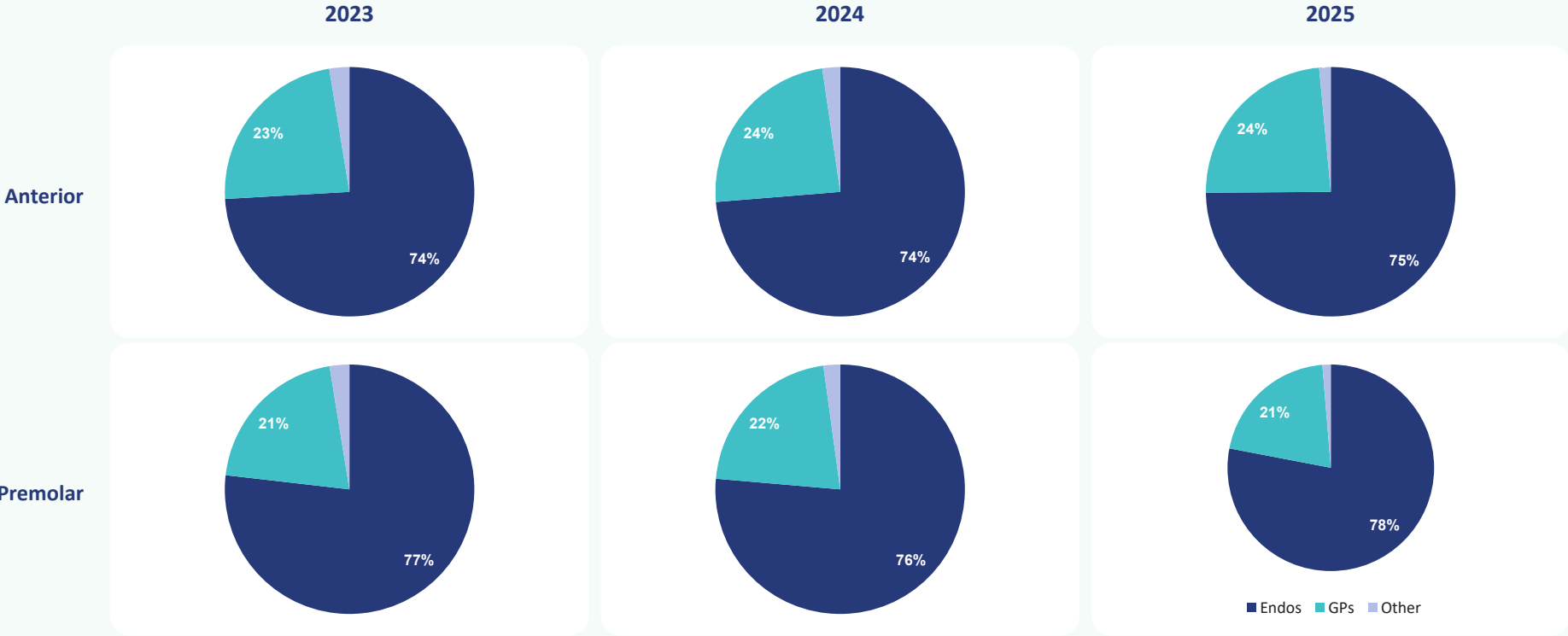

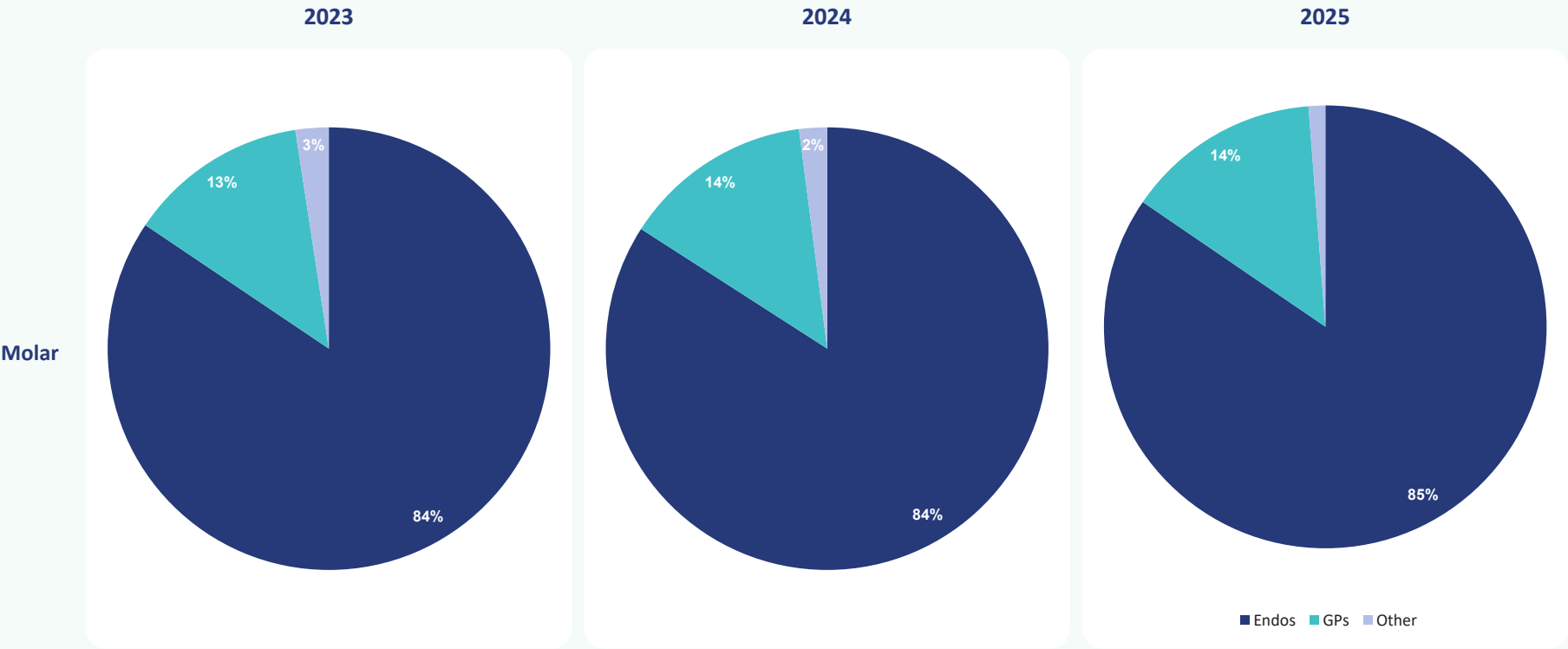

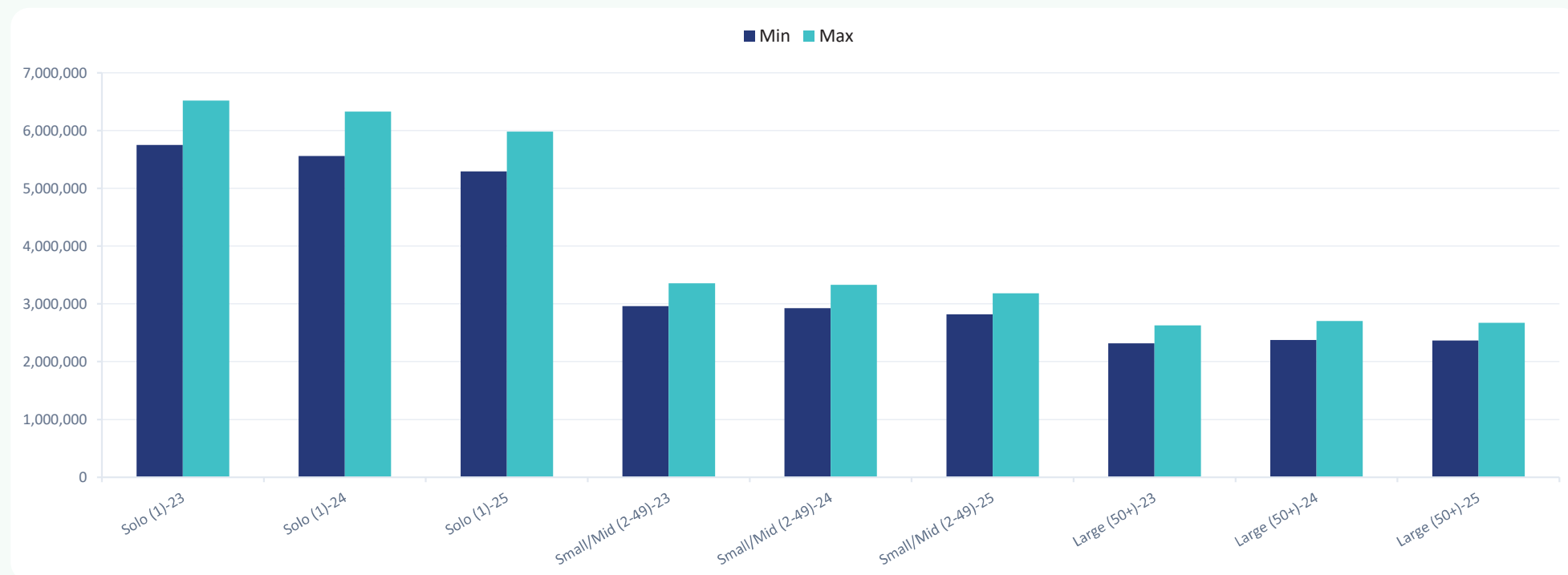

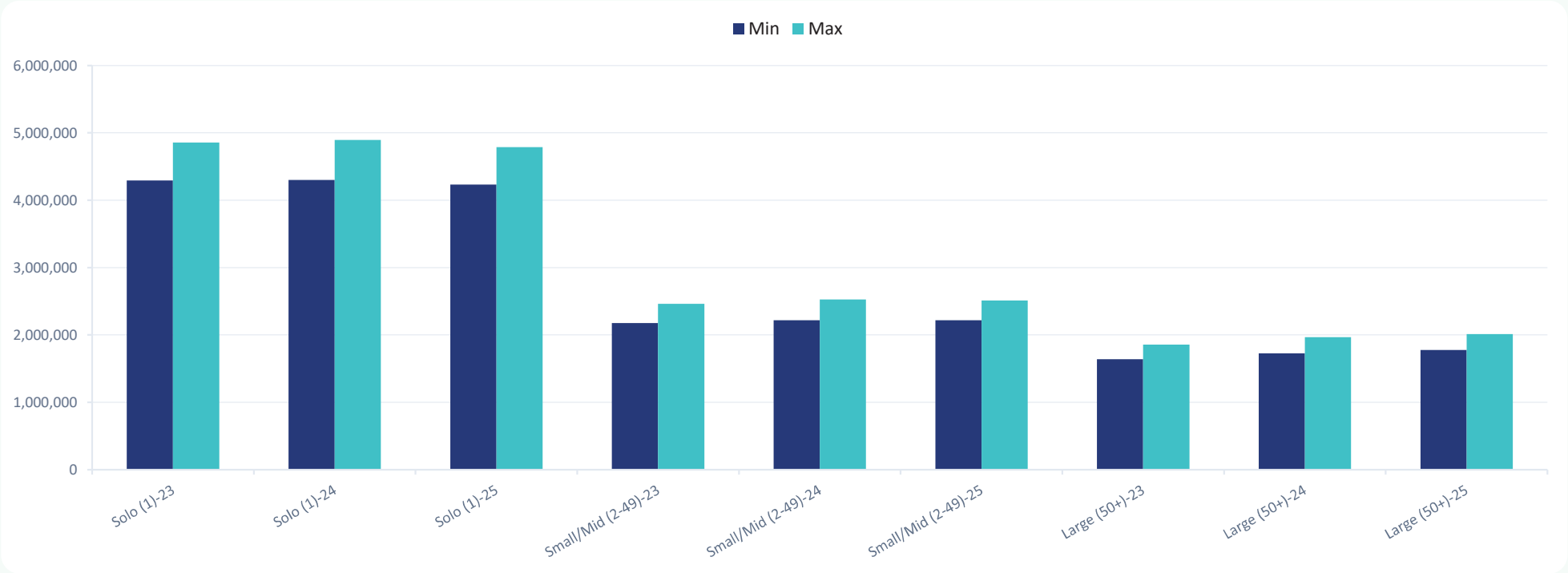


- Solo practices (1 location) saw the steepest declines: -3.1% in 2024 and -5.2% in 2025.

Provider Group Practice Size — 2023 to 2025

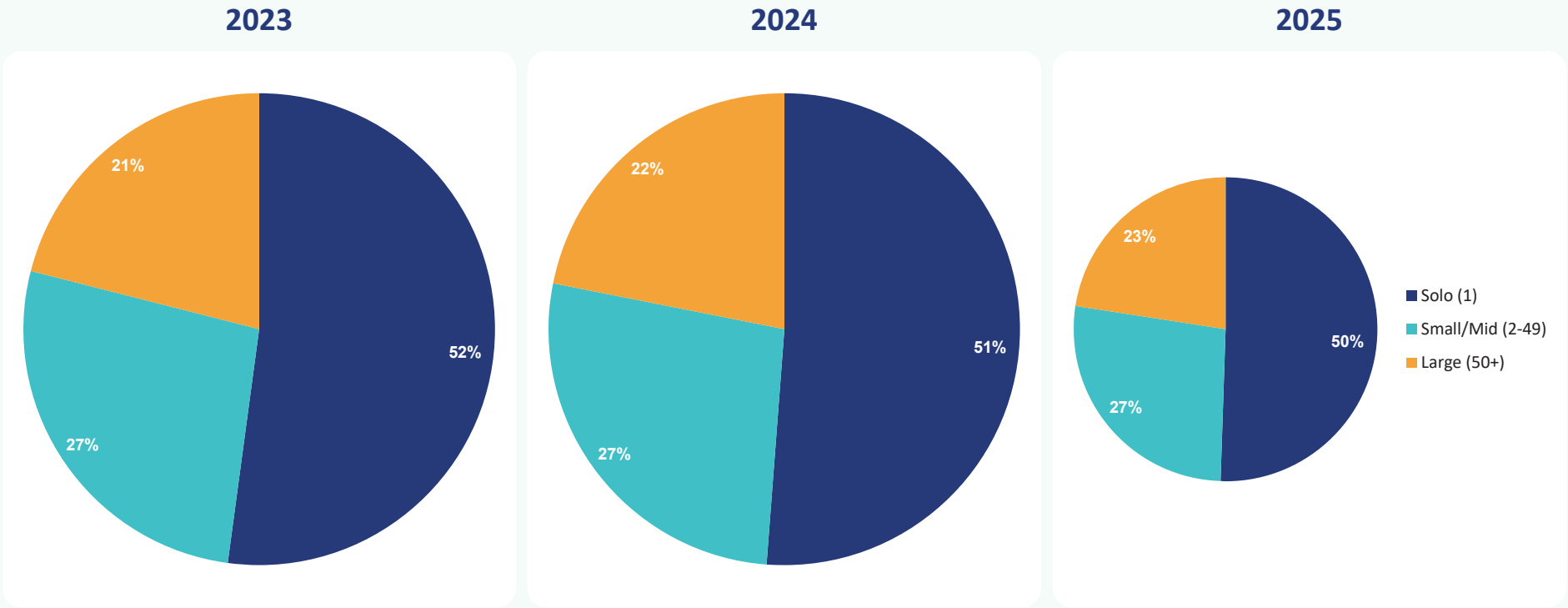


- Patient volume by group practice size mirrors treatment volume — solo practices declining most, large groups (50+) holding up best.

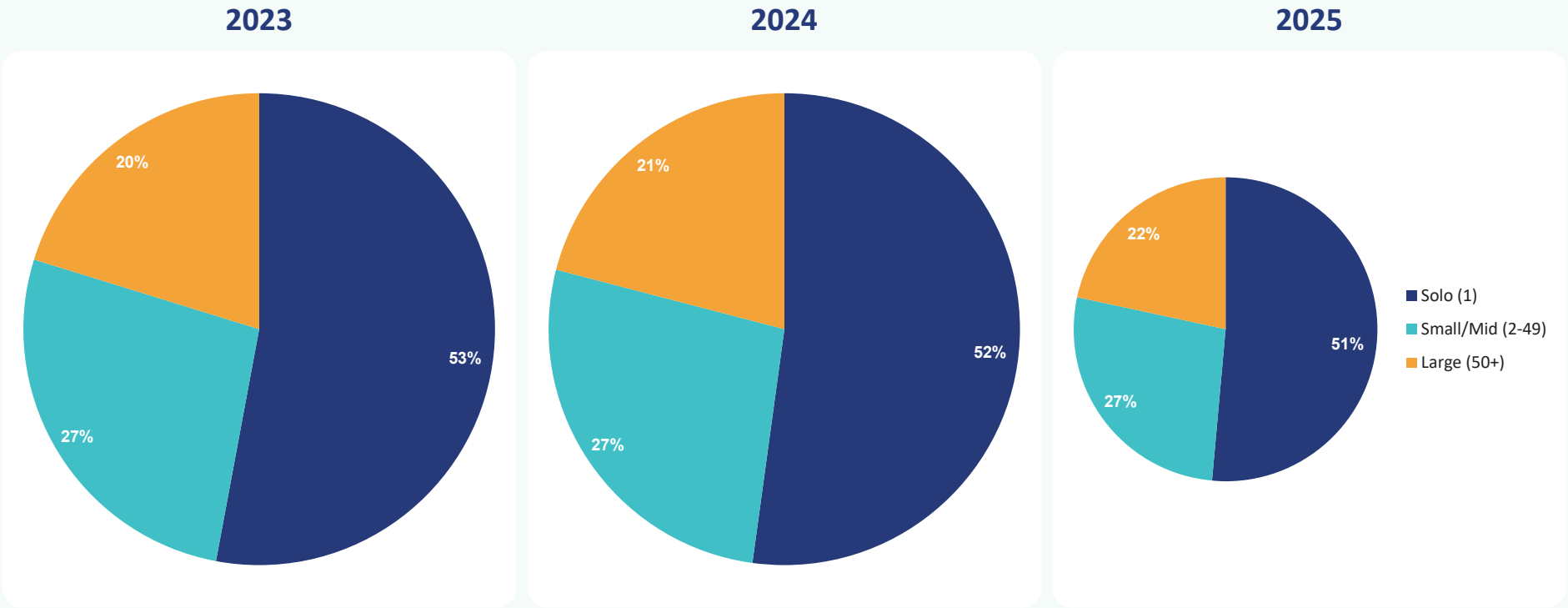

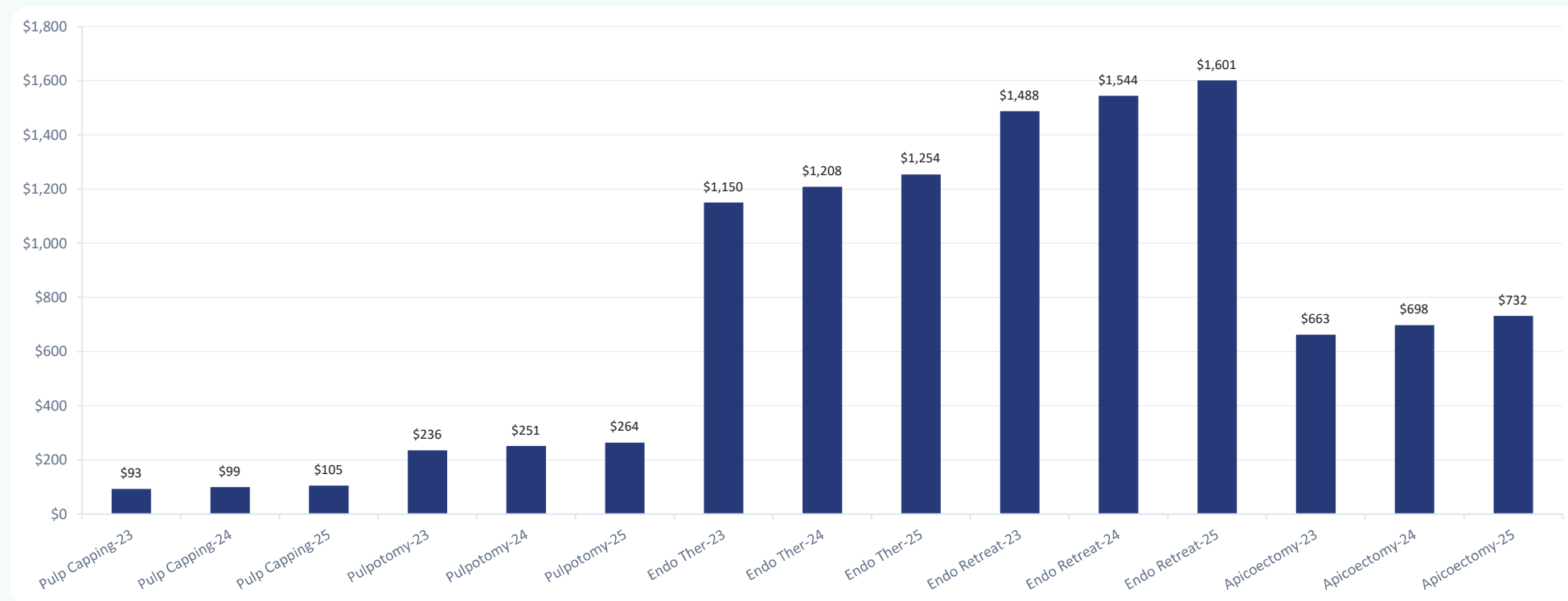

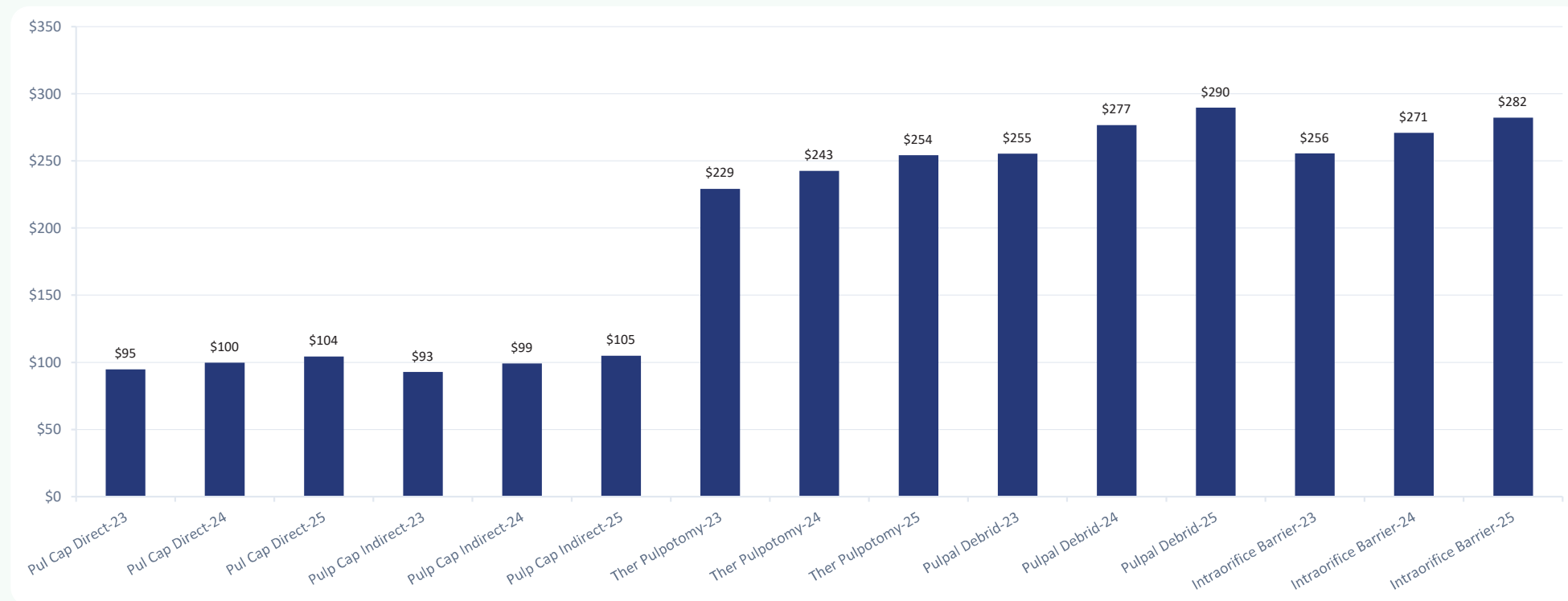

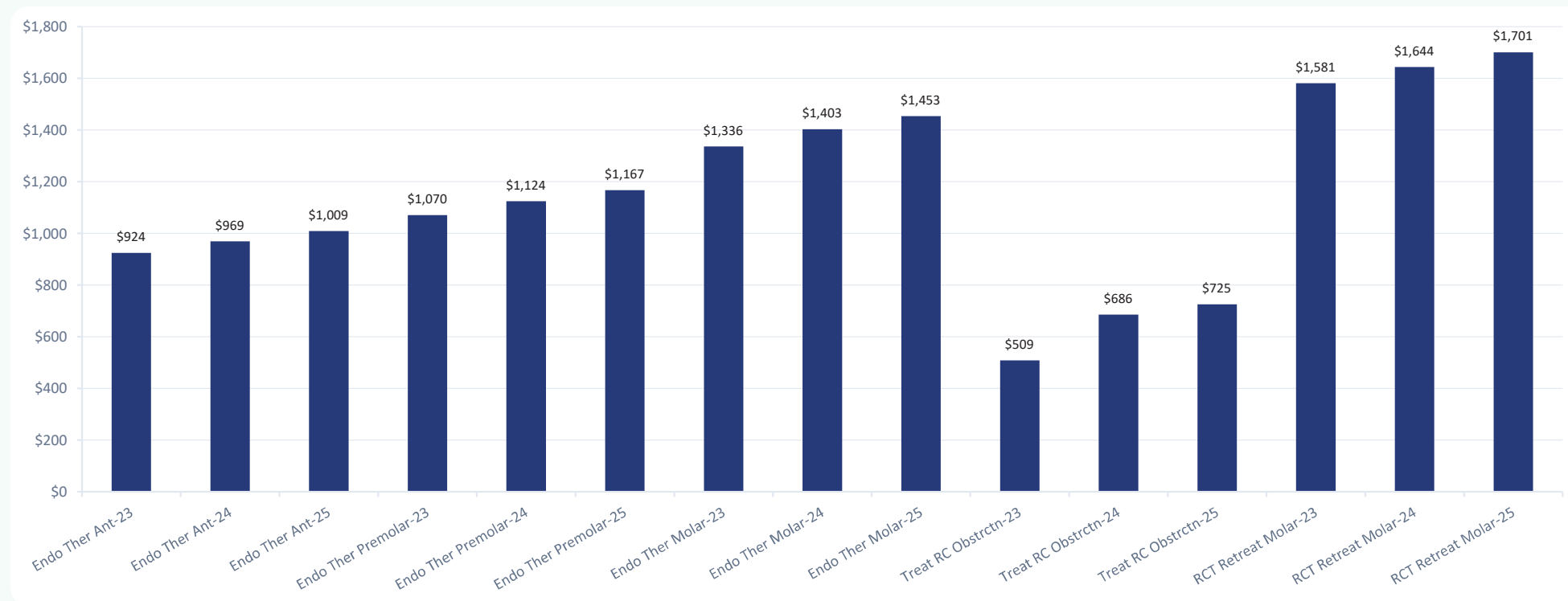

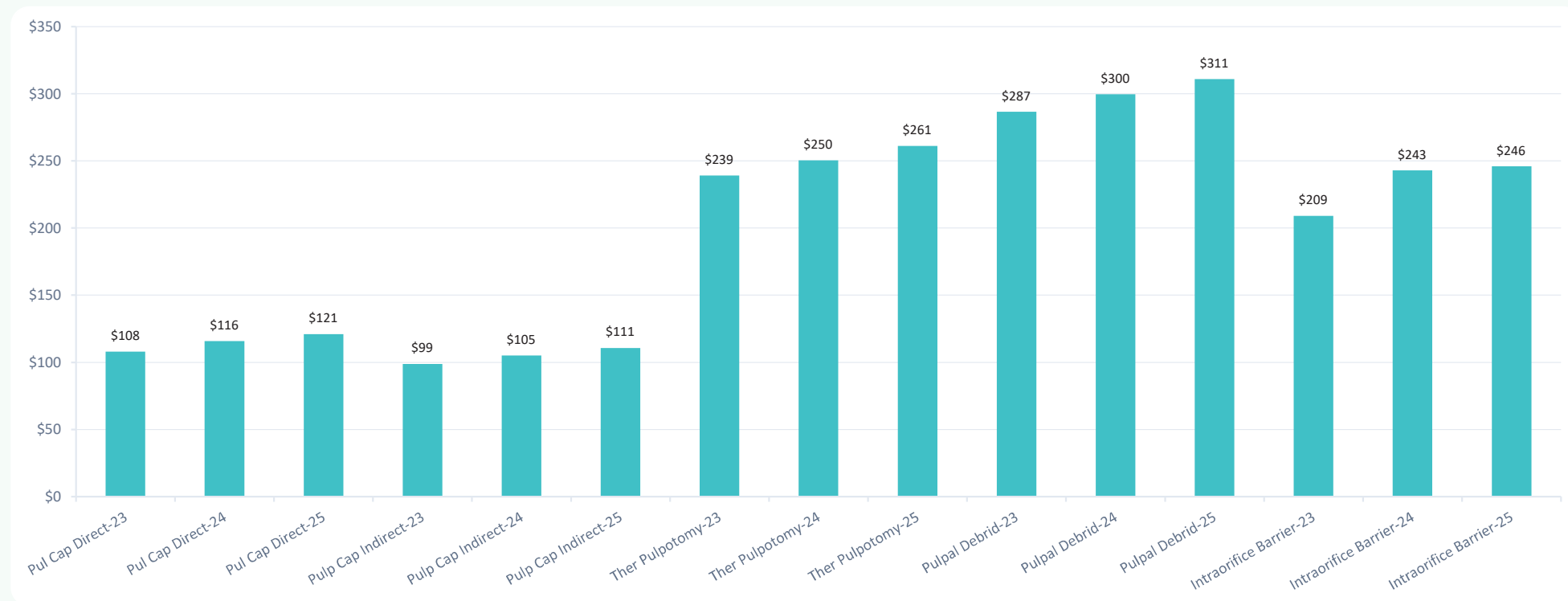

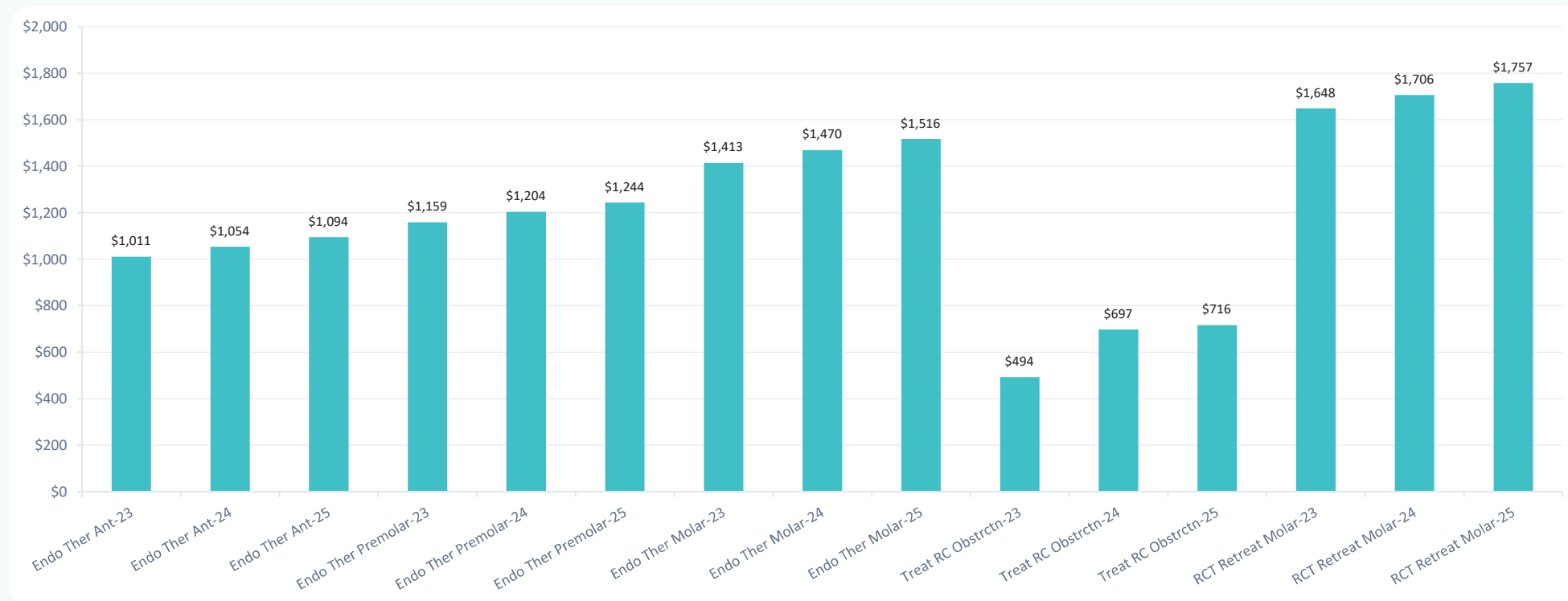

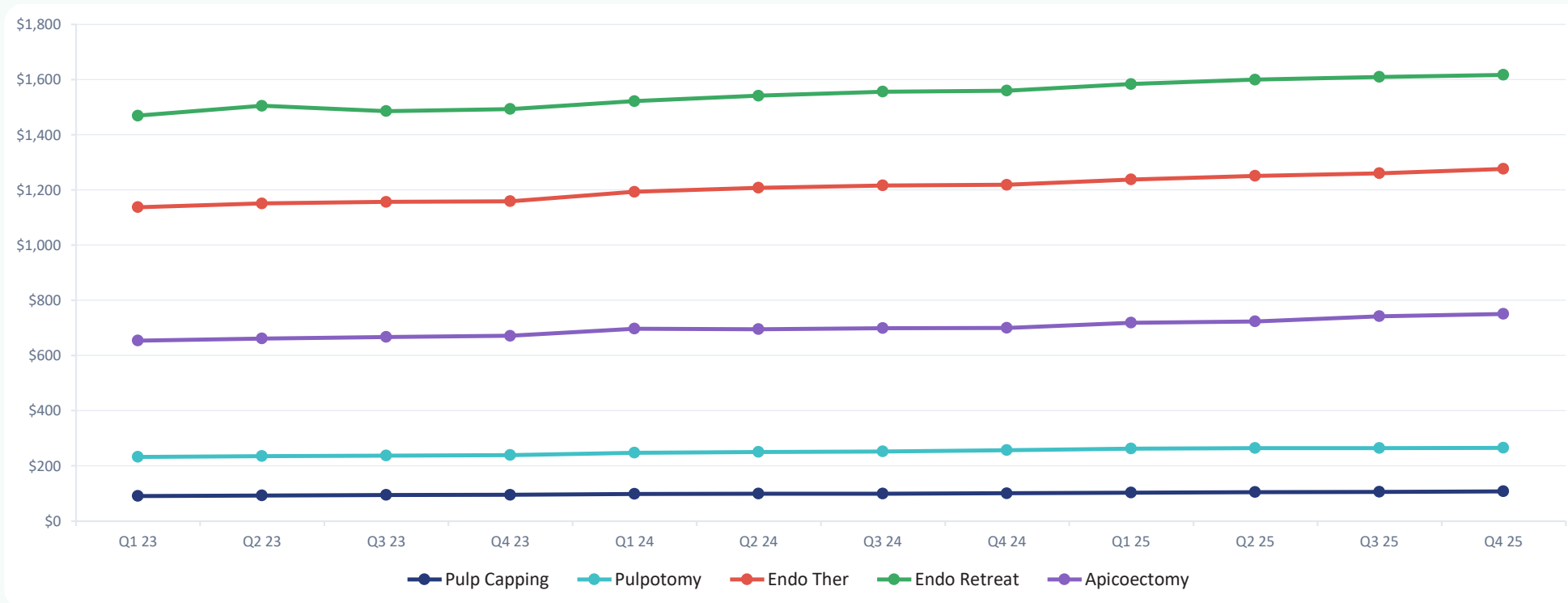

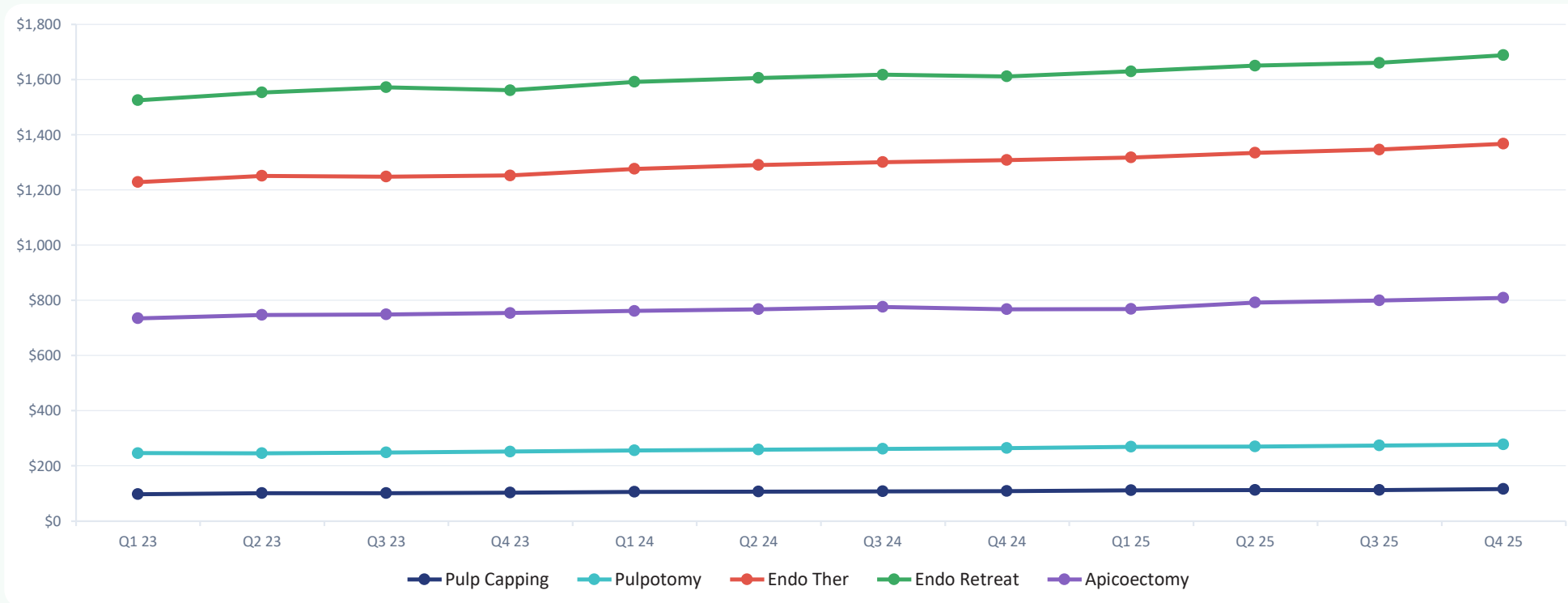

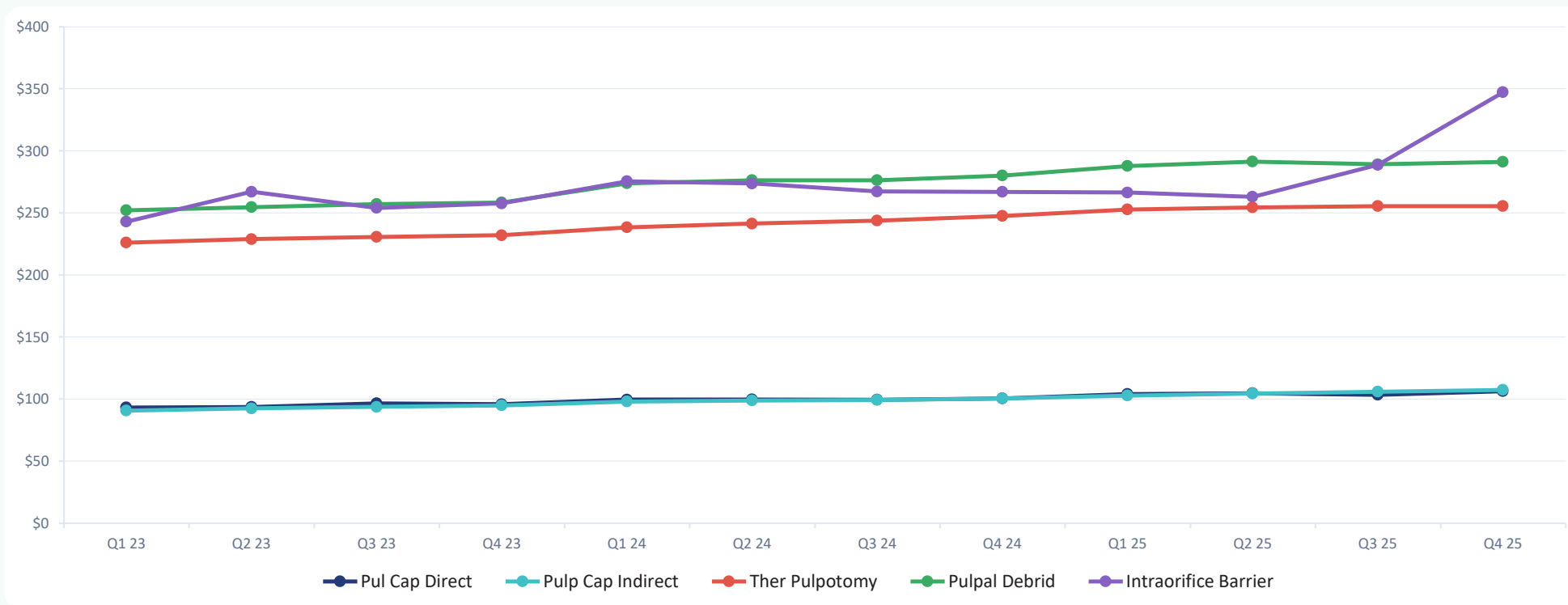

Largest Volume Procedures — Q1 2023 to Q4 2025 (1 of 2)

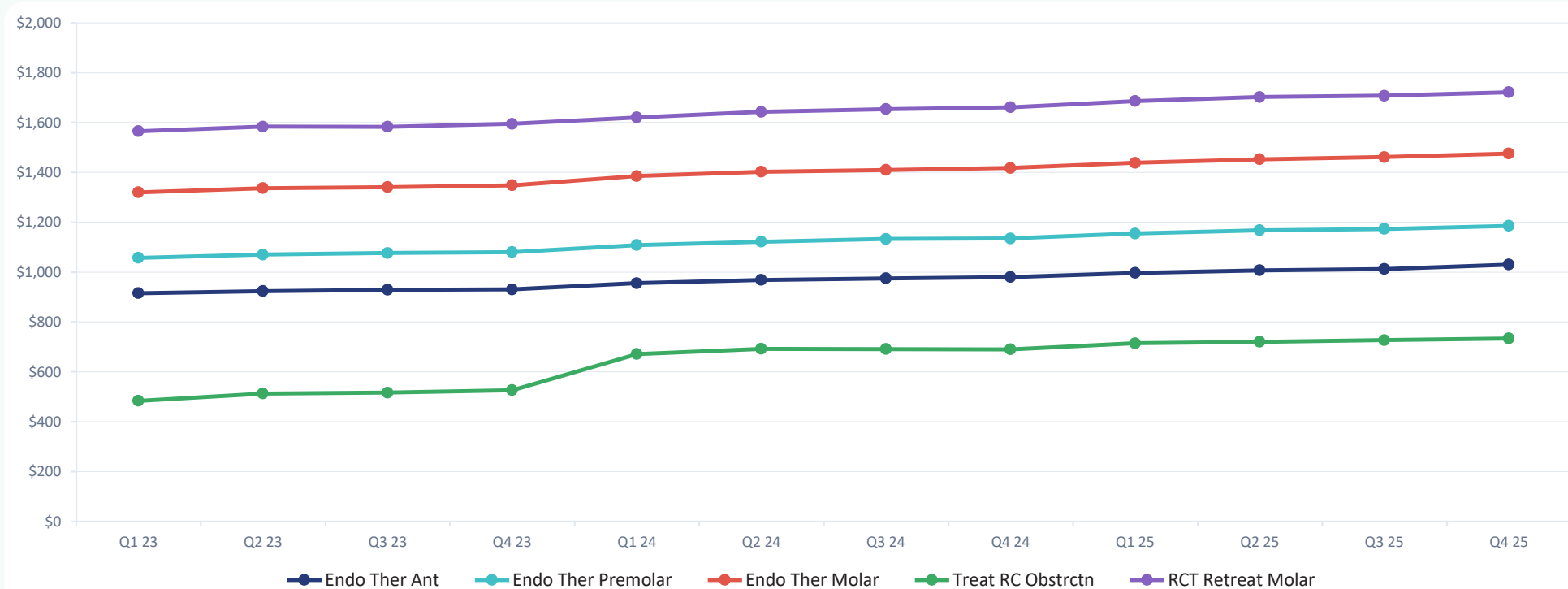

Largest Volume Procedures — Q1 2023 to Q4 2025 (2 of 2)

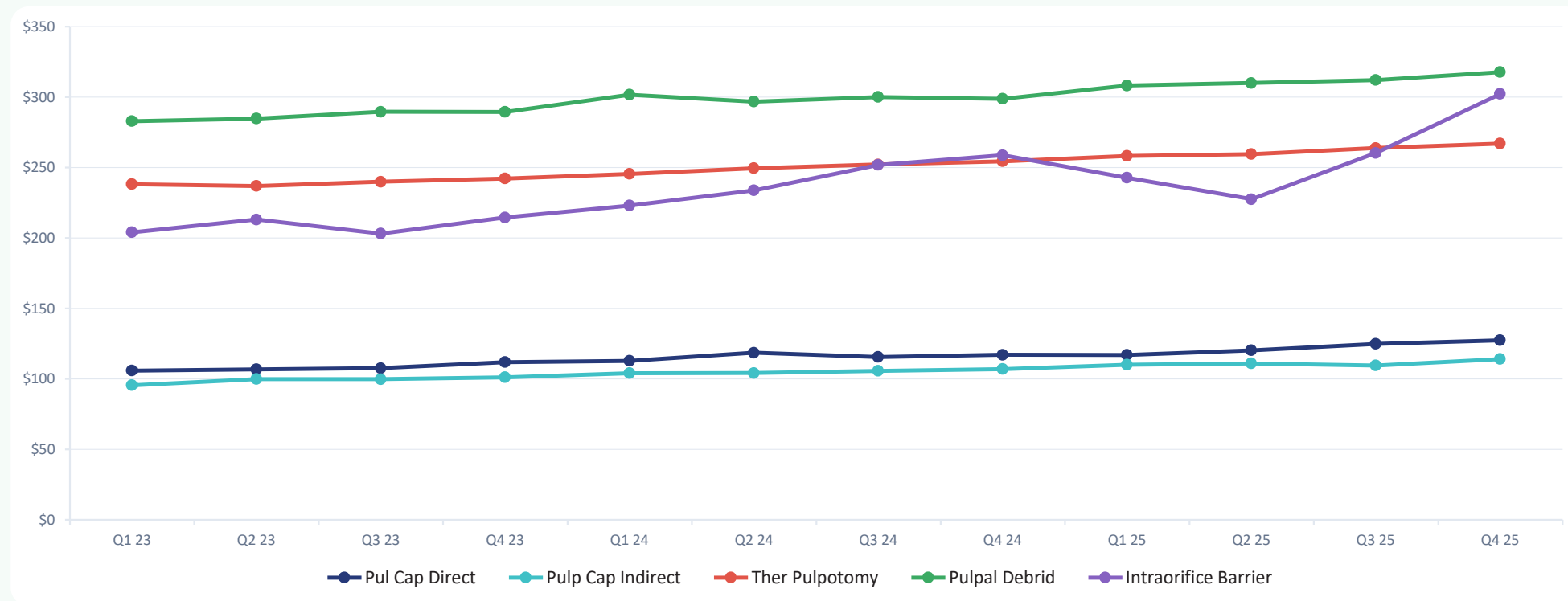

Largest Volume Procedures — Q1 2023 to Q4 2025 (1 of 2)

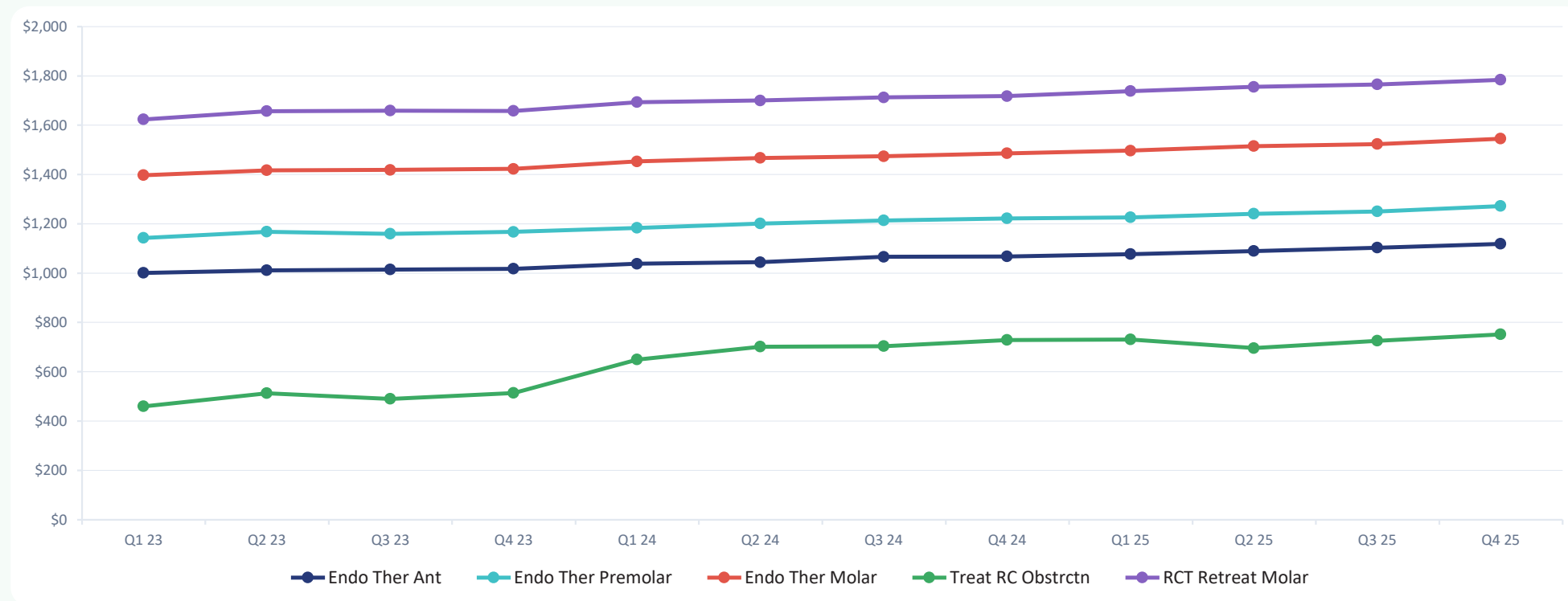
